**BASEBALL – The Wilson A1010-Pro is the official baseball of the OSAA. Due to contractual obligation the OSAA will mandate use of these balls for all state championship games, first round through final sites. It is the host school’s responsibility to provide official Wilson baseballs for all games at home sites. We are no longer shipping baseballs to host schools during the playoffs. Instead, following the semifinals, the OSAA will ship one dozen Wilson baseballs to each school for each game they hosted during the playoffs. Wilson baseballs will be provided at Volcanoes Stadium for the state championship finals by the OSAA.**

## PRE-EVENT

1. **EVENT MANAGEMENT CHECKLIST:** This communication is vital to a successful contest and should take place as soon as the teams are finalized. Each host school should send a completed Event Management Checklist and a diagram of the seating plan to potential opponents.
2. **GAME TIMES:** All 1st, 2nd, and 3rd round, quarterfinal and semifinal games are scheduled for 4:30 p.m., unless the two schools involved mutually agree to play at a different time. **EXCEPTION:** All 1st, 2nd, and 3rd round, quarterfinal, and semifinal games on a holiday or on a Saturday or Sunday are scheduled for 1 p.m., unless the two schools involved mutually agree to play at a different time. If two schools cannot agree on starting time, OSAA will make the decision.
3. **UMPIRES:** With the exception of the finals, the host school is to obtain three umpires from the association that services its home games. OSAA will pay the umpires through each commissioner.
4. **OSAA BANNER:** The OSAA along with our title sponsors, U.S. Bank and Les Schwab Tires, purchased and distributed a 3' x 10' banner for all member schools in recent years. The banner recognizes your school as a member of the OSAA. We encourage you to display this banner prominently when you are hosting a state championship event. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.
5. **PA SCRIPT:** Please ensure that your announcer has a copy of the attached PA script and reads these announcements during each state championship game.
6. **PROGRAMS:** The host school has the right to produce a roster sheet / game program. These may be handed out or sold by the host school. The OSAA will produce and sell programs at the state championship final site.
7. **MEMBER SCHOOL DISCOUNT TICKETS:** Order deadline is May 21. Remember tickets are good for all games, first round through finals site. Each school may purchase up to six discount tickets for \$18 each.
8. **TICKET BOOTH SIGNS:** There are four signs attached, Ticket Prices, Finals Online Ticket Information, Pass Gate, and Spectator Conduct. Please ensure that these signs are posted at your gates prior to each state championship game.
9. **ADMISSION: All persons must have a ticket or pass to enter.**

a. **General Admission Tickets:**

First Round – Quarterfinals	Adults \$6	Students \$4
Semifinals	Adults \$7	Students \$5
Finals	Adults \$8	Students \$5

- b. **Member School Discount Tickets:** Each school may purchase up to six discount tickets for \$18 each. The athletic director or principal must complete the form and the tickets must be paid for when ordered.

- c. **Administrative Complimentary Tickets:** Each school that participates in a state championship game will receive the following complimentary tickets: Superintendent, 2; Principal, 2; Athletic Director, 2. The *host school* is to provide these tickets for all games prior to the final site.
- d. **Passes:** ONLY the OSAA Gold Card, OSAA VIP, OSAA Media, Baseball/Softball Media and Baseball Discount tickets, which will admit the bearer only with photo ID, are to be honored at any OSAA State Championship event. No school, athletic district, officials association, etc., passes are to be accepted.
10. **OFFICIAL BALL ADOPTION:** The Wilson A1010-Pro is the official baseball of the OSAA. Due to contractual obligation the OSAA will mandate use of these balls for all state championship games, first round through final sites. It is the host school's responsibility to provide official Wilson baseballs for all games at home sites. We are no longer shipping baseballs to host schools during the playoffs. Instead, following the semifinals, the OSAA will ship one dozen Wilson baseballs to each school for each game they hosted during the playoffs. Wilson baseballs will be provided at Volcanoes Stadium for the state championship finals by the OSAA.
11. **STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS – RADIO, TELEVISION AND INTERNET BROADCASTS** (*OSAA Handbook, Executive Board Policies*): “The OSAA owns the rights to and coordinates any radio, television and/or Internet broadcasts for state championship events, first round through championship final. Media outlets that wish to broadcast any state championship event must contact the OSAA for permission and/or to negotiate a rights fee well in advance of the event. The OSAA shall contact the host school athletic director if a media outlet has been granted permission to broadcast an early round event. If the OSAA has not contacted the host school athletic director to confirm that permission has been granted, the broadcast shall not be allowed. It shall be the responsibility of the media outlet to make all necessary arrangements with the host school athletic director and to pay for any phone line charges or installation fees for any early round event. The OSAA will coordinate arrangements with media outlets at all final sites.” (Revised Fall 2007)
12. **REPORT FINAL SCORE:** Email [stevev@osaa.org](mailto:stevev@osaa.org) or call 503.682.6722, ext. 232, and report the final score IMMEDIATELY following your game. Be sure to say which classification and sport you are reporting. Results will be posted each evening to [www.osaa.org/baseball/](http://www.osaa.org/baseball/).
13. **NFHS 2009 BASEBALL STATE CHAMPIONSHIP GAME STATISTICS:** [www.osaa.org/baseball/bbstat.asp](http://www.osaa.org/baseball/bbstat.asp)  
We are asking for your support and cooperation in gathering specific baseball game statistics for use by the National Federation Baseball Rules Committee. Use the website address above to complete the necessary information following each playoff game you host.
14. **EVENT MANAGEMENT EXPENSES:** **Within one week** after completion of each game the host school shall forward the following to the OSAA office:
- a. **Event Management & Ticket Report** – Please use this form to record ticket sales, and game management expenses such as PA announcer, scoreboard operator, ticket-takers, sellers, and supervision. Programs and game films are not reimbursable expenses.
  - b. **Important Reminders** –
    - 1) Expenses are **not** to be withheld from ticket sales.
    - 2) Use only one report form per game.
    - 3) Receipts must be attached.
    - 4) OSAA will pay officials through the commissioner.

# SPECTATOR CONDUCT

- All cheers, comments and actions shall be in direct support of one's team. No cheers, comments or actions shall be directed at one's opponent or at contest officials. Some examples of inappropriate conduct or actions that are not permitted are: turning backs, holding up newspapers or jeering at cheerleaders during opposing team introductions; disrespecting players by name, number or position; negative cheers or chants; throwing objects on the floor.
- Spectators are not permitted to have signs or banners (larger than 8 ½ by 11 inches), confetti, balloons or glass containers. Spectators are required to wear shirts.
- Spectators are not permitted to have artificial noisemakers. Some examples of artificial noisemakers are Thunder Stix, cowbells, clappers and air horns.
- Spectators shall not be permitted to use vulgar/offensive or racially/culturally insensitive language. Spectators shall not be permitted to engage in any racially/culturally insensitive action.
- Spectators who fail to comply with Association or site management spectator conduct expectations may be expelled from the contest.
