1. **EMERGENCY PLAN:** In the event of an emergency, natural disaster, fire, war, etc. that forces postponement or cancellation of an OSAA State Championship event, information will be posted to the home page of the OSAA website (osaa.org) and distributed to statewide media outlets. 4. **SPECTATOR CONDUCT AT OSAA SANCTIONED EVENTS:** (*OSAA Handbook, Executive Board Policies*)  
 "In addition to the general expectations included in the OSAA Constitution, Rule 3, that school officials "...shall take all reasonable measures to ensure that the school's students and supporters maintain a sportsmanlike attitude toward all events..." the following specific expectations regarding spectator conduct at all OSAA sanctioned events, including regular and post season competition, are provided: (Revised Fall 2008)
- A. All cheers, comments and actions shall be in direct support of one's team. No cheers, comments or actions shall be directed at one's opponent or at contest officials. Some examples of inappropriate conduct or actions that are not permitted are: turning backs, holding up newspapers or jeering at cheerleaders during opposing team introductions; disrespecting players by name, number or position; negative cheers or chants; throwing objects on the floor. (Revised Fall 2008)
  - B. Spectators are not permitted to have signs or banners (larger than 8 ½ by 11 inches), confetti, balloons or glass containers. Spectators are required to wear shirts.
  - C. Spectators are not permitted to have artificial noisemakers. Some examples of artificial noisemakers are Thunder Stix, cowbells, clappers and air horns.
  - D. Spectators shall not be permitted to use vulgar/offensive or racially/culturally insensitive language. Spectators shall not be permitted to engage in any racially / culturally insensitive action. (Revised Fall 2008)
5. **SPECTATOR PARKING:**
- a. Parking passes are \$6 each day, with no in/out privileges. Pre-purchased parking tickets are limited to availability and may be purchased only at the Rose Quarter Box Office. The Rose Quarter parking lot will not be available for RV's, motor homes, or other overnight camping.
  - b. Book a hotel close to the MAX / Free Rail Zone and ride MAX for free.

6. **STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS – VIDEOTAPING** (*OSAA Handbook, Executive Board Policies*): "Any spectator may videotape State Championships from the stands, providing they do not obstruct the view of others or require extra space. Use of a tripod in the stands is prohibited for safety reasons. When a school films its own team during a State Championship, the official school representative will be granted the privilege of filming from the press box or other designated area established by the OSAA. NOTE: Videotaping or filming is for private use only. Televising, including live or delayed broadcasts and cable, is prohibited unless a contract is signed with the OSAA."
7. **STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS – RADIO, TELEVISION AND INTERNET BROADCASTS** (*OSAA Handbook, Executive Board Policies*): "The OSAA owns the rights to and coordinates any radio, television and/or Internet broadcasts for state championship events, first round through championship final. Media outlets that wish to broadcast any state championship event must contact the OSAA for permission and/or to negotiate a rights fee well in advance of the event. The OSAA shall contact the host school athletic director if a media outlet has been granted permission to broadcast an early round event. If the OSAA has not contacted the host school athletic director to confirm that permission has been granted, the broadcast shall not be allowed. It shall be the responsibility of the media outlet to make all necessary arrangements with the host school athletic director and to pay for any phone line charges or installation fees for any early round event. The OSAA will coordinate arrangements with media outlets at all final sites." (Revised Fall 2007)
8. **AWARDS:** Team trophies will be presented at the conclusion of each trophy game on Saturday. The sportsmanship award, all-tournament team recognition, second place and championship trophies and medals and championship bracket board will be presented at the conclusion of each gender's final game Saturday evening.
- a. **Trophies:** Champion through sixth place trophies will be presented to the top teams in each classification.

- b. **Medals:** Fifteen medals will be presented to both the champion and second place teams in each classification.
  - c. **U.S. Bank/Les Schwab Tires All-Tournament Teams:** Medals will be presented to members of the All-Tournament 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Teams in each classification (five members on each team).
  - d. **Qwest Player of the Game:** One player from each team in each of the 22 final site games will be recognized as that team's Qwest Player of the Game. The winners will be announced over the PA and will receive a certificate and commemorative gift from Qwest the week following the championships. The certificate and gift will be mailed to the student's athletic director.

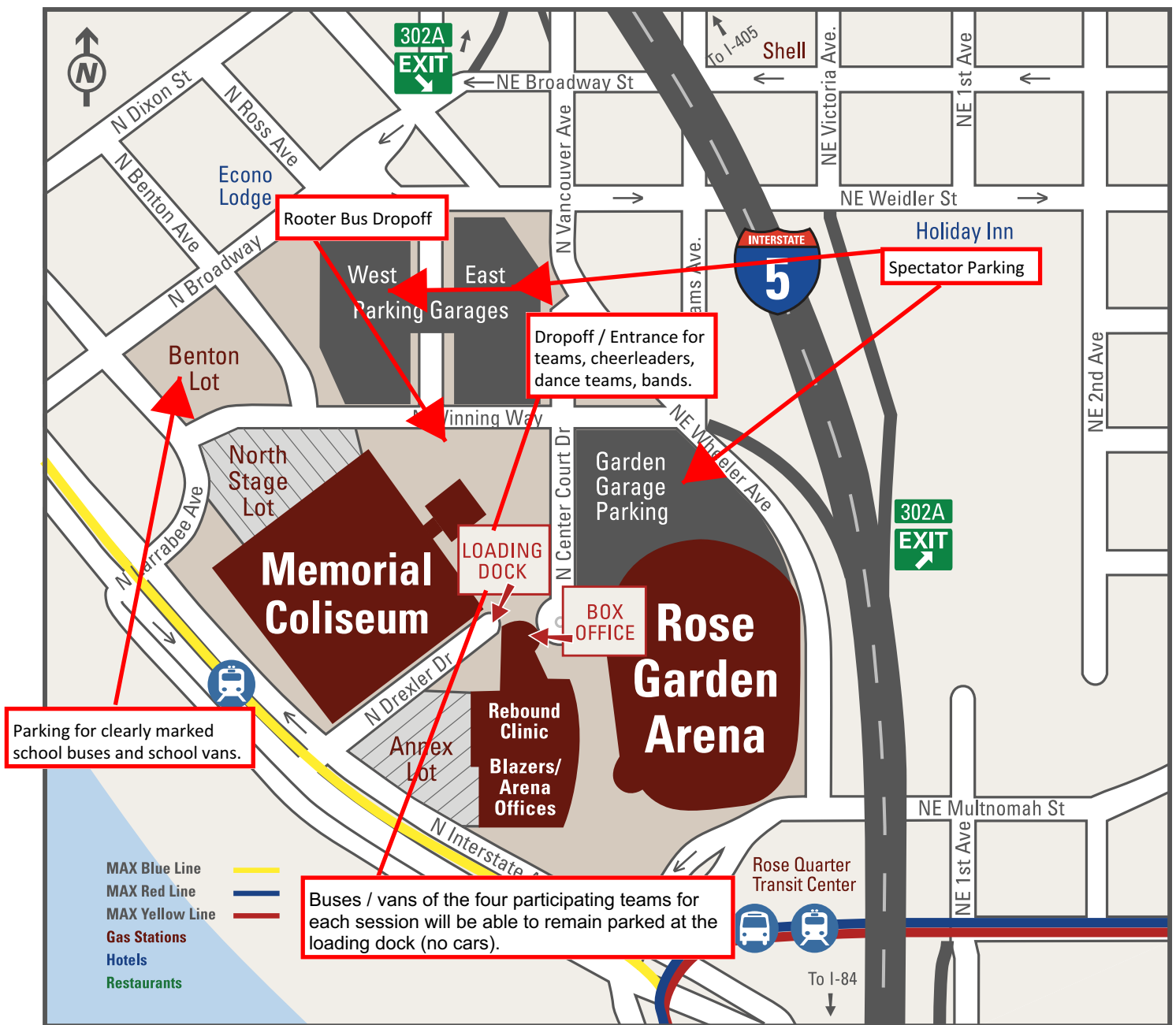

# ROSE QUARTER PARKING / DIRECTIONS



**From I-84 Westbound:** Follow signs to I-5 N Seattle, take Rose Quarter exit, cross MAX tracks, left on Multnomah (2nd light), right on Interstate (3rd light), enter parking garages as directed.

**From HWY 26 Eastbound:** Take I-405 North/ Seattle to Everett St. exit, right on Everett St., proceed on Everett St. and cross over Steel Bridge, Left on Interstate Ave. (1st light, enter parking as directed. **OR** Take I-405 North exit and proceed to I-5 South exit, from I-5 South take Rose Quarter exit, proceed straight through 2 lights, enter parking garages as directed. **OR** Take I-405 South exit, proceed to I-5 North, from I-5 North take the Rose Quarter Exit, Left on Broadway (2nd light), left on Vancouver Ave. (2nd light), proceed straight, enter parking garages as directed.

**From I-5 Southbound:** take Rose Quarter exit, proceed straight through 2 lights, enter parking garages as directed.

**From I-5 Northbound:** take Rose Quarter exit, left on Broadway (2nd light), left on Vancouver Ave. (2nd light), proceed straight, enter parking garages as directed. **OR** Take City Center Exit (before Marquam Bridge), proceed North on Front Street (Naito Parkway) over the Steel Bridge, left on Interstate Ave. (1st light), enter parking garages as directed. **OR** Take I-405 Exit to Everett St., right on Everett St., proceed over Steel Bridge, left on Interstate Ave. (1st light), enter parking garages as directed.
