### SPECTATOR INFORMATION

1. **EMERGENCY PLAN:** In the event of an emergency, natural disaster, fire, war, etc. that forces postponement or cancellation of an OSAA State Championship event, information will be posted to the home page of the OSAA website (osaa.org) and distributed to statewide media outlets. A recorded message will also be accessible by calling the OSAA office at 503.682.6722 x0.
2. **ADMISSION:** Purchase tickets for all sessions at anytime during the event. Doors open at 4pm and first performances begin at 4:30pm. Will Call windows are located inside the main entrance of the Coliseum. VISA / MasterCard are accepted.
  - a. **Purchase tickets on the side of the Coliseum that your team will be facing for performances.**

    - 2) **Show, 4A and 3A/2A/1A Teams will dance facing the EAST side** of the Coliseum- Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 24, 25, 26 and upper sections.
    - 3) **6A and 5A teams will dance facing the WEST side** of the Coliseum- Sections 11 through 17 and upper sections.
  - b. **Parking Passes - \$4.** Pre-purchased parking passes are limited to availability and purchased at the Rose Quarter Box Office or the internet, not at any other outlets. Parking passes will not be mailed, but may be printed if purchased on the internet.

4. **SPECTATOR SEATING:** Be sure to purchase tickets on the side of the Coliseum that your team will be facing for performances. All Show, 4A and 3A/2A/1A Teams will dance facing the EAST side of the Coliseum- Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 24, 25, 26 and upper sections. All 6A and 5A teams will dance facing the WEST side of the Coliseum- Sections 11 through 17 and upper sections.

5. **SPECTATOR CONDUCT AT OSAA SANCTIONED EVENTS:** (*OSAA Handbook, Executive Board Policies*)

"In addition to the general expectations included in the OSAA Constitution, Rule 3, that school officials "...shall take all reasonable measures to ensure that the school's students and supporters maintain a sportsmanlike attitude toward all events..." the following specific expectations regarding spectator conduct at all OSAA sanctioned events, including regular and post season competition, are provided: (Revised Fall 2008)

- a. All cheers, comments and actions shall be in direct support of one's team. No cheers, comments or actions shall be directed at one's opponent or at contest officials. Some examples of inappropriate conduct or actions that are not permitted are: turning backs, holding up newspapers or jeering at cheerleaders during opposing team introductions; disrespecting players by name, number or position; negative cheers or chants; throwing objects on the floor. (Revised Fall 2008)
- b. Spectators are not permitted to have signs or banners (larger than 8 ½ by 11 inches), confetti, balloons or glass containers. Spectators are required to wear shirts.
- c. Spectators are not permitted to have artificial noisemakers. Some examples of artificial noisemakers are Thunder Stix, cowbells, clappers and air horns.
- d. Spectators shall not be permitted to use vulgar/offensive or racially/culturally insensitive language. Spectators shall not be permitted to engage in any racially / culturally insensitive action. (Revised Fall 2008)

6. **AWARDS:**

- a. **Trophies:** Trophies will be presented to 50% of the teams in a division up to a maximum of five in each division.
- b. **All-State Medals:** Individual medals will be presented to members of the DDCA All-State team.

The judges' scores will be computer tabulated. Results will be posted to the OSAA website at the conclusion of the preliminaries indicating which teams are advancing to the Finals. Results for the Finals will be posted following the awards ceremonies. Please instruct your fans and local media to go there for official results.
