TICKET POLICY FOR MEMBER SCHOOLS

- A. **ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLIMENTARY TICKETS.** These tickets should be used to supervise your students when your team is participating.
- Team Sports** (Baseball, Basketball, Soccer, Softball, and Volleyball). The *host school* is to provide these tickets for all games prior to the final site. The OSAA office will provide these tickets to the participating schools at the final site.
 - Each school that participates in a 6A, 5A, 4A, 3A, 2A State Championship game will receive the following complimentary tickets: Superintendent, 2; Principal, 2; Athletic Director, 2.
 - Each school that participates in the 1A State Championship game will receive four administrative complimentary tickets the following complimentary tickets: Superintendent / Principal, 2; Athletic Director, 2.
 - Football** – The *host school* is to provide these tickets for all games except semifinals and finals. The OSAA office will provide these tickets to the participating schools at the semifinal and final site. Each school that participates in a state championship game will receive the following complimentary tickets: 6A – 15 tickets, 5A – 15 tickets, 4A – 12 tickets, 3A – 12 tickets, 2A – 10 tickets, 1A – 6 tickets.
 - Individual Sports** (Cross Country, Swimming, Wrestling, and Track and Field). No administrative complimentary tickets are provided in individual sports. Schools are encouraged to purchase Discount Tickets.
 - Activities** (Cheer, Dance, Band and Orchestra, and Choir). Schools participating in the state level events may receive a maximum of six administrative complimentary tickets IF REQUESTED from the OSAA.
 - Executive Board Members** receive two VIP tickets good for any activity. Board members may also request two reserved seats at any OSAA event that uses reserved seating. Board members associated with participating schools will not receive duplicate tickets.
 - Delegate Assembly Members** receive one VIP ticket that is good for any OSAA activity.
- B. **MEMBER SCHOOL DISCOUNT TICKETS** – (Baseball, Basketball, Cross Country, Football, Soccer, Softball, Track and Field, Volleyball, and Wrestling). Discount tickets are not sent automatically. The Member School Discount Ticket Order Form is located in the Handbook and Forms section of the OSAA website, www.osaa.org.
- Discount tickets are good for all state championship games, first round through final site.
 - These tickets are for any additional school personnel who do not already receive tickets, i.e., bus drivers, assistant coaches, etc.
 - The form must be signed by the principal or athletic director.
 - All tickets shall be punched at the site for the appropriate round with the exception of volleyball and basketball.
- C. **PASSES** – Only the OSAA Gold Card, OSAA VIP and Media passes, which will admit the bearer only with photo ID, are to be honored at any OSAA State Championship event. No school, athletic district, officials association, etc., passes are to be accepted.
- D. **BUS DRIVERS** – Schools are responsible for all bus driver admissions. The OSAA does not provide passes for bus drivers.
- E. **COACH / TEAM ADMISSION** – Each Coaches Packet will contain the following number of passes:
- Basketball** – 6A – 18; 5A, 4A, 3A, 2A, 1A – 16 participant passes will be given to each participating team.
 - Cross Country** – Each participant will receive an individual participant number with a bar-coded label, participants' numbers must be worn for admission. The number of coaches passes per school are determined as follows: one coach's pass for schools with an individual qualifier, two coach's pass for schools with a boys or girls team, three coach's pass for schools with an individual qualifier and a team, and four coach's pass for schools that qualify two teams. **MAXIMUM 4 PER SCHOOL.**

3. Football

- a) **6A** – Visitor 24 Passes / Home 24 Passes – 17 Field Access (coaches, ball boys, managers, etc.) and 7 Press Box & Field Access (coaches and filmers). Each team will be given 60 General Admission tickets for the players. Parking Passes: 6. Each home team will receive an additional 4 passes for the chain crew at all sites excluding the semifinal and final site.
- b) **5A** – Visitor 24 Passes / Home 24 Passes – 17 Field Access (coaches, ball boys, managers, etc.) and 7 Press Box & Field Access (coaches and filmers). Each team will be given 50 General Admission tickets for the players. Parking Passes: 6. Each home team will receive an additional 4 passes for the chain crew at all sites excluding the semifinal and final site.
- c) **4A** – Visitor 22 Passes / Home 22 Passes – 15 Field Access (coaches, ball boys, managers, etc.) and 7 Press Box & Field Access (coaches and filmers). Each team will be given 40 General Admission tickets for the players. Parking Passes: 6. Each home team will receive an additional 4 passes for the chain crew at all sites excluding the semifinal and final site.
- d) **3A** – Visitor 18 Passes / Home 18 Passes – 15 Field Access (coaches, ball boys, managers, etc.) and 3 Press Box & Field Access (coaches and filmers). Each team will be given **33** General Admission tickets for the players. Parking Passes: 6. Each home team will receive an additional 4 passes for the chain crew at all sites excluding the semifinal and final site.
- e) **2A** – Visitor 18 Passes / Home 18 Passes – 15 Field Access (coaches, ball boys, managers, etc.) and 3 Press Box & Field Access (coaches and filmers). Each team will be given 33 General Admission tickets for the players. Parking Passes: 6. Each home team will receive an additional 4 passes for the chain crew at all sites excluding the semifinal and final site.
- f) **1A** – Visitor 16 Passes / Home 16 Passes – 13 Field Access (coaches, ball boys, managers, etc.) and 3 Press Box & Field Access (coaches and filmers). Each team will be given 24 General Admission tickets for the players. Parking Passes: 6. Each home team will receive an additional 4 passes for the chain crew at all sites excluding the semifinal and final site.

4. Soccer – 6A – 26; 5A, 4A, 3A, 2A, 1A – 24 participant passes will be given to each participating team.

5. Swimming –

- a) Each participant will receive an individual participant pass that must be punched for admission.
- b) Each school will receive two coaches passes. If a school has more than two coaches, they must purchase a ticket before entry.

6. Track – Each participant will receive an individual participant number, participants' numbers must be worn for admission.

- a) 6A, 5A, 4A Coaches Passes – The total number of male participants determines the number of coaches passes for the boys' team. The total number of female participants determines the number of coaches passes for the girls' team.

MAXIMUM OF SIX PASSES PER SCHOOL.

- 1) One coach's pass for schools with 1 - 3 participants **OR**
- 2) Two coaches' passes for schools with 4 - 7 participants **OR**
- 3) Three coaches' passes for schools with eight or more participants.

- b) 3A, 2A, 1A Coaches Passes – The total number of participants determines the number of coaches passes. **MAXIMUM OF THREE PASSES PER SCHOOL.**

- 1) One coach's pass for schools with 1 - 3 participants **OR**
- 2) Two coaches' passes for schools with 4 - 7 participants **OR**
- 3) Three coaches' passes for schools with eight or more participants.

7. Volleyball – 6A – 18; 5A, 4A, 3A, 2A, 1A – 16 participant passes will be given to each participating team.

8. Wrestling – Each participant will receive a participant pass for all wrestlers that qualify. The total number of participants determines the number of coach's passes a school will receive.

- a) Two coach's passes for schools with 1 – 3 wrestlers **OR**
- b) Three coach's passes for schools with 4 – 7 wrestlers **OR**
- c) Four coach's passes for schools with 8 – 11 wrestlers **OR**
- d) Five coach's passes for schools with 12 – 15 wrestlers **OR**
- e) Six coach's passes for schools with 16 or more wrestlers.
