INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Your school/league/officials association may nominate one full member high school in each of the six classifications. Photocopy and complete a separate nomination form for each school nominated. You cannot nominate your own school. Be certain to complete the entire evaluation form.
- 2. You are encouraged to meet collectively with the head coaches in all sports that your school sponsors programs, or the contest officials within your association, to determine which school(s), if any, your school/league/officials association believes is worthy of this recognition. <u>Rivalry should not be a factor in making this decision.</u> Even the most bitter of rivals are capable of demonstrating exemplary sportsmanship when competing against each other. If an opponent is deserving, nominate them, no matter how bitter the rivalry.
- 3. Enclose with each nomination form a letter of nomination on your school's/league's/officials association's stationery. This letter of nomination should summarize why your school/league/officials association believes the school being nominated is worthy of being considered for this award by the Sportsmanship Review Committee.
- Email the nomination form(s) and letter(s) to Marci McGillivray, OSAA Associate Director, marcim@osaa.org, so that it is received no later than 4 p.m. Friday, May 1, 2015. Nominations received after this deadline will not be accepted.
