SUBJECT: Update on the Proceedings of the Classification and Districting Committee and Final Recommendation

The Classification and Districting Committee for the 2014-2018 four-year time block met at the OSAA office in Wilsonville on October 7, 2013 to receive testimony and review written communication thus far received.

The audience initially received a review of the Classification and Districting timeline and charge from Executive Director Tom Welter. The Committee then received testimony by 29 different people representing 24 member schools.

Following public testimony, the Committee adjourned to a closed work session to review and discuss the testimony and continue reviewing the more than 50 pieces of written correspondence it had received since the last meeting in September.

During the closed work session, the Committee went classification by classification and reviewed school placements and cutoff points. Here is a breakdown by classification of the changes from Draft #9 to the Committee's Final Recommendation.

1A Classification

The Committee received no verbal testimony but did receive written correspondence from one league and one school. The only proposed change moves Rogue Valley Adventist from the Skyline League to the Mountain Valley League.

2A Classification

The Committee received no verbal testimony or written correspondence. No changes were recommended.

3A Classification

There was significant verbal testimony and written correspondence received from schools at the 3A classification. The majority of those who testified or wrote in seemed to acknowledge that the Committee could improve the league alignments and school placements in Draft #9. The Committee spent quite a bit of time discussing this particular group of schools in an attempt to mitigate travel concerns in some areas. In the end, Committee members believed that adding a sixth league and moving schools around in certain areas was the best way to get at those concerns. The Committee knows that not every school will be happy with this proposal but believes it's the best option for this classification of schools across the board. The 3A/4A cutoff point was changed to 331 resulting in St. Mary's (Medford) moving back down to 3A, providing a fifth school in southern Oregon at the 3A and leaving the 4A Skyline Conference with six schools. Valley Catholic has informed OSAA that their current enrollment and future projections are significantly above this new cutoff point (more than 15%) and, therefore, have been placed at 4A.

4A Classification

Committee members dropped the 4A/5A cutoff point to 675 in order to create a better ratio from top to bottom at the 4A classification, resulting in La Salle Prep moving up to the 5A classification. With St. Mary's (Medford) dropping back down to 3A, all 4A leagues will have six teams with the exception of the Greater Oregon League.

5A Classification

Committee members discussed and received multiple pieces of correspondence referencing the Columbia River Conference and the Intermountain Conference being placed together. The Committee knew that a proposal putting the two leagues together may not be looked at favorably by all schools involved and that was the clear response from the Columbia River Conference schools. Committee members chose to separate out the two into a four-team league and a five-team league. La Salle Prep was moved into the Northwest Oregon Conference based on the change to the 4A/5A cutoff point.

6A Classification

The Committee spent time reviewing the verbal testimony and written correspondence received from 6A schools. In the end, no changes were recommended from Draft #9.

It should be understood that **the release of the Committee's Final Recommendations is not the final step in the public process.** Member schools and the public will also have the opportunity to respond to the Committee's Final Recommendations to the Executive Board in writing prior to and/or in person at the public meeting at which the Board will take action on the Final Recommendations. The Board will consider member school written input and public testimony prior to acting on the Committee's Final Recommendations, and the Delegate Assembly will subsequently meet to adopt the cutoff points and league quantities for the new time block.

The Final Recommendations of the Classification and Districting Committee will be considered by the OSAA Executive Board and Delegate Assembly on October 28, 2013 at the Holiday Inn, Wilsonville. The Executive Board meeting will convene at 9am, with the Delegate Assembly meeting to follow at 1pm.
