

Administrator Workshop Attendance Requirement (OSAA Handbook, Executive Board Policies)

Each member school shall ensure that at least one representative participate in one of the annual Administrator Workshops presented by OSAA staff. Roll shall be taken at the Workshops to confirm compliance with this policy.

Should it be determined that a member school failed to have a representative at any of the Administrator Workshops, that school shall be placed on probation during the Association year of non-attendance. The Board shall consider the probationary status of the school when assigning penalties for any violations of OSAA Regulations by the school that might occur during the period of probation.
