



**KIDS in the GAME** offers financial assistance to low income families for sports registration fees through our **PASS** program. Through a large donation from the Julia Love Pritt Foundation in Seattle, services in the Pacific Northwest are expanding; for example, Family Access Network (FAN) advocates in Central Oregon have families involved in the program.

Quick details about the **PASS** program:

- Families can apply for up to \$150.00 towards sports registration fees for children ages 4-18
- Families are eligible to apply every 3 months, or seasonally for school sports
- Funded activities include school sports, intramural sports, swim lessons, gymnastics, martial art lessons and more
- Not funded: club/elite team sports, travel teams, sports camps or personal training.
- Families are expected to pay \$10.00 toward fees (e.g., if an activity costs \$60.00, the program pays \$50.00)
- Check are made payable directly to the sports organization
- Documents that can be used to qualify families (uploaded with the application):
  - Free/Reduced Lunch letter
  - SNAP benefits letter
  - Washington or Oregon State Health Plan benefits letter
  - Foster Care letter
- A family email address is required to apply
