The Marine Corps Jazz Orchestra, the premier jazz ensemble of the United States Marine Corps, will be performing 7:00 PM, Friday, Oct. 6, at Oregon State University's Memorial Student Union & 7:30 PM, Saturday, Oct. 7, at Western Oregon University's Pacific Room. This concert is part of a two-week tour through Washington, Oregon and California intended to express the United States Marine Corps' gratitude and appreciation for the American people, as well as to highlight the talents of Marine musicians in a way that inspires others to join their ranks.

The Marine Corps Jazz Orchestra has performed across the country in many of America's most distinguished jazz venues and festivals, to include the Lincoln Center and the Monterey Jazz Festival. The Orchestra includes members from the world-renowned "The Commandant's Own" U.S. Marine Drum & Bugle Corps, and "The President's Own" U.S. Marine Band, as well as the 10 elite U.S. Marine Corps Field Bands. Unlike each of the other military services' premier jazz ensembles, the Marine Corps Jazz Orchestra is selected on an annual basis to highlight the best jazz performers in any given year.

The Marine Corps and distinguished musicians share a unique appreciation for the discipline, dedication, precision, and commitment it takes to master the art of music. During their tour, the Marine Corps Jazz Orchestra will bring many of these commonalities to light, exemplifying our shared values through the power of music. In addition to this performance, the Marines in the band will be conducting clinics as part of the Marine Corps' educational outreach efforts throughout the tour.
