3. **COMPETITION DATES AND TIMES:** Thursday, May 16 – 8am      Friday, May 17 – 8am      6A & 5A Saturday, May 18 – 8am

B. 6A & 5A will combine at Babette Horenstein Tennis Center for the finals on Saturday, May 18.

5. **SPECTATOR CONDUCT AT OSAA SANCTIONED EVENTS** (OSAA Handbook, Executive Board Policies)      (Revised Winter 2015)

In addition to the general expectations included in the OSAA Constitution, Rule 3, that school officials...shall take all reasonable measures to ensure that the school's students and supporters maintain a sportsmanlike attitude toward all events... the following specific expectations regarding spectator conduct at all OSAA sanctioned events, including regular and post season competition, are provided:

- All cheers, comments and actions shall be in direct support of one's team. No cheers, comments or actions shall be directed at one's opponent or at contest officials. Some examples of inappropriate conduct or actions that are not permitted are: turning backs, holding up newspapers or jeering at cheerleaders during opposing team introductions; disrespecting players by name, number or position; negative cheers or chants; throwing objects on the floor.
- Spectators are not permitted to have signs or banners (larger than 8 ½ by 11 inches), confetti, balloons or glass containers. Fathead type items are considered signs and shall not be larger than 8 ½ by 11 inches. Spectators are required to wear shirts.
- Spectators are not permitted to have artificial noisemakers. Some examples of artificial noisemakers are Thunder Stix, cowbells, clappers and air horns.
- Spectators shall not be permitted to use vulgar/offensive or racially/culturally insensitive language. Spectators shall not be permitted to engage in any racially / culturally insensitive action.
- Spectators who fail to comply with Association or site management spectator conduct expectations may be expelled from the contest.

6. **SPECTATOR PARKING:**

- A. Ample parking is available in any of the complex parking lots.
  - B. Overflow parking lot – located on Walker Road, south of the tennis center, adjacent to the softball fields. The entrance is a driveway from the THPRD parking lot and an apartment complex. A paved pathway leads you north, directly to the tennis center.
  - C. Additional overflow parking on Saturday, May 18 is available at the Cornell Oaks Business Park located north of the complex, off Blueridge Drive.
  - D. Improperly parked vehicles are subject to towing, at the owner’s expense. Please avoid parking in the Fred Meyer parking lot.
  - E. Parking patrols will be in service during the championships. Thanks for your cooperation.
7. **CLEAN UP:** Tennis sites have generously displaced their own patrons to host the high school state championships. Players and fans are urged to keep courts and surrounding areas clean by throwing garbage in the trash receptacles.
8. **SERVICE ANIMALS:** Trained guide dogs and service animals assisting guests are welcome at OSAA State Championships. All other animals are prohibited. All service animals must remain on a leash or in a harness, and be in full control of the handler, at all times. Handlers are responsible for any damage or injuries caused by their animals, must properly dispose of waste in appropriate containers and must take appropriate precautions to prevent property damage or injury.
9. **LOST AND FOUND:** Players should not leave clothing or valuables in playing area. THPRD is not responsible for any lost or stolen items. During the event, Lost & Found will be at the OSAA Event Office or other location designated by the host facility / OSAA Staff. Beginning the first business day after the event, please contact THPRD at 503.629.6331 to claim any missing items.
10. **AWARDS:** All awards will be presented following the conclusion of play on Saturday. Players and teams should make every effort to stay for the awards presentation.
- A. **Trophies:** Champion through fourth place trophies will be presented in each championship.
  - B. **Medals:** Individual medals will be presented to the first through fourth place singles and doubles players, plus the consolation champion, in each classification.
  - C. **Wilson Jumbo Tennis Balls:** Each singles and doubles champion will also receive a Wilson Jumbo Tennis Ball in recognition of his/her achievement.

Welcome to the Tualatin Hills Tennis Center! We are proud to be the host site for your 2019 OSAA Tennis State Championships. We would request your assistance in making this the best year ever.

- We have developed a court usage scheme to better accommodate your event. The Tennis Center has set aside the six indoor courts. Court one and six will have bleachers on them to handle the large crowds expected to view the tournament. The other four will be used for match play. Player and spectator access will be through the end doors. Four outdoor courts are also reserved for the tournament and will be used unless weather forces us inside. If it rains, the OSAA rain schedule will be in effect and the four indoor air structure courts will also be used.
- Players, coaches & parents please keep equipment, bags and personal belongings in your possession. We are not responsible for lost or stolen articles.
- The THPRD Tennis office is for Tennis Center staff only. The tournament director is the only tournament staff person who will be admitted.
- **Warm up Courts will be assigned on a first come first serve basis by checking in at the Tennis Center front desk**
  - Courts will be available each day at 7:00am
  - One court per school and sharing courts may be necessary
  - *Courts must be empty 15 minutes before scheduled matches begin.*

  - *The THPRD Tennis Center now has free Wi-Fi, to help you locate these courts.*
- Please help us keep the Tennis Center and area grounds garbage free. Players, coaches & parents are responsible for keeping trash from the grounds and facilities and for assisting in picking up at the end of each day. Extra trash receptacles will be provided.
- **COURTESY PAYS:** proper tennis etiquette is expected at all times. Noise, disruptive behavior, abusive or offensive language, on or off the court, will not be tolerated. Striking court fixtures or surfaces with racquets is prohibited. We reserve the right to refuse participation or viewer access to anyone violating rules & regulations.

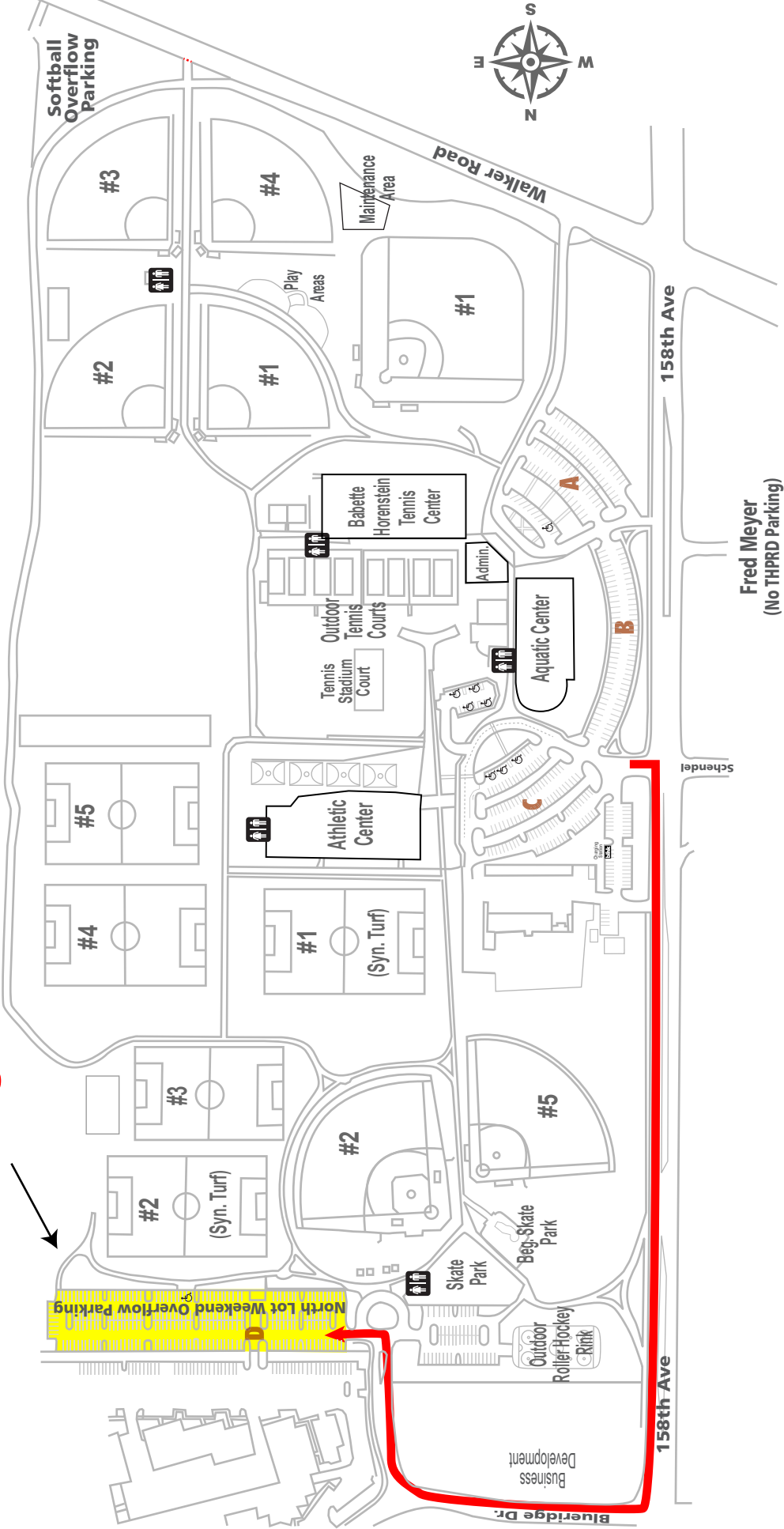
