Westview High School seeks a highly qualified individual to serve as Boys Head Golf Coach. A successful candidate will possess the following qualities:

- Demonstrated ability to be a positive leader in a golf program, developing and instructing young athletes academically, physically and emotionally.
- Ability to communicate effectively to a variety of stakeholders through various methods, including athletes, parents, families/staff, AD's office and public relations.
- Technical knowledge of golf strategies, skill development, and coaching techniques

The Coach will be responsible for supporting all aspects of the high school program including:

- Tryouts & formation of teams followed by creation of program standards & culture.
- Creating practice plans.
- Supervising trips for tournaments and in season matches.
- Tracking the academic progress of student athletes and facilitating necessary support to ensure their academic eligibility and long-term success.

The Coach reports directly to the Principal and Athletic Director. Stipend to be paid per Beaverton School District policies for head coaches based on experience. Some responsibilities outside the spring season may include coaches' meetings, player meetings, school events, and fundraising

Qualified applicants would have 2+ years of coaching experience, with previous head coaching experience preferred. Applicants should have a willingness to become a member of our community and to improve through professional development.

All new hired coaches will need to complete the following prior to employment:

1. NFHS Certification.
2. First Aid Card.
3. District Fingerprinting/Criminal Check.
4. Completion of OSAA Concussion Test.
5. Completion -OSAA Steroid Program.
6. Completion- OSAA Heat Acclimatization/Heat Illness Prevention.
7. Completion of All District Requirements, OSAA paperwork and employment forms.
