SUBJECT: Update on the Proceedings of the Classification and Districting Committee

The Classification and Districting Committee for the 2014-2018 four-year time block met at the OSAA office in Wilsonville on May 20, 2013 to receive testimony and review written communication thus far received.

The audience initially received a review of the Classification and Districting timeline and charge from Executive Director Tom Welter. The Committee then received testimony by 22 different people representing 19 member schools.

Following public testimony, the Committee adjourned to a closed work session to review and discuss the testimony and more than 35 pieces of written correspondence it had received since the last meeting in April.

Following the closed work session, the Committee has reached consensus on the following issues.

Number of Classifications: Committee members have maintained consensus to recommend a six classification system.

<u>Petitions to Play Down:</u> Committee members have still only received one Petition to Play Down request from a member school (La Pine). <u>Schools that are interested in playing outside of their assigned classification through a Petition to Play Down must submit their information to the OSAA by June 1 in order to receive consideration.</u>

<u>Schools Playing Outside Assigned Classification:</u> The Committee was formally notified of a school changing its mind about playing up a classification (La Salle Prep). <u>Schools that are interested in playing outside of their assigned classification by choosing to play up a classification must submit their request to the OSAA by June 1 in order to receive consideration.</u>

School Enrollment Projections: Committee members heard from a number of schools about their desire to change their proposed placement based on enrollment projections for 2012-13 and into the future. Historically the OSAA's Classification and Districting Committee hasn't placed schools based on projections, but has instead waited until a school is able to actually realize the new enrollment numbers before making a change. The Committee will have enrollment figures from ODE for 2012-13 when it meets again in September. The Committee believes at this point in the process that it is better to wait until it receives new enrollment figures before possibly adjusting proposed cutoff points and/or moving schools into new classifications.

Based on discussion and correspondence received, the Committee made the following changes when creating Draft #8:

<u>1A:</u> The Committee continued to support a 1A/2A cutoff of 90. Committee members are aware that a number of schools right around that cutoff point may, in fact, be under 90 when the new enrollment figures are received in the Fall and that this will most likely necessitate changes to the makeup of some 1A leagues. The Committee is interested in hearing ideas from the Big Sky (11), Old Oregon (5) and High Desert (12) leagues about their thoughts on changes that would better balance the numbers in these three leagues.

2A: The Committee moved Lakeview back to 3A based on a request from the school to play at their assigned classification and maintained a seventh league at the 2A classification. Committee members are aware that a number of schools right around the 1A cutoff point may, in fact, be under 90 when the new enrollment figures are received in the Fall and that this will most likely necessitate changes to the makeup of some 2A leagues. These changes will most likely involve schools currently proposed for the Mountain View Conference and Southeast Oregon Conference. The Committee maintained two leagues in northeast Oregon and one league on the coast.

<u>3A:</u> The Committee placed Lakeview back in the Southern Cascade League and granted a geographic exception to Bandon to play in the 2A Sunset Conference. Committee members are aware that putting Lakeview and Coquille in the same league creates a difficult travel and is looking for suggestions from schools on where to place 3A schools in order to mitigate this situation.

4A: La Salle Prep was placed back into the Tri-Valley Conference after rescinding their earlier petition to play up. No other changes were made at the 4A classification.

<u>5A:</u> The Committee discussed at length a request from Central to stay at 4A rather than be placed at 5A. Ultimately Committee members decided not to change the 5A/4A cutoff point at this time.

<u>6A:</u> Committee members spent considerable time discussing league alignments at the 6A classification, specifically those north of Salem. The Committee believes that calls to separate out the three Portland-area private schools into different leagues have merit and is proposing to move St. Mary's Academy back to the Mt. Hood Conference. Committee members also considered a request from Sherwood to be in a league with Newberg, Tigard or Tualatin but ultimately decided that their current placement in the Metro League is viable. The Committee is aware that a decision by Lakeridge to play 5A and/or new enrollment figures for several schools could have an impact on these league placements prior to its final recommendation this Fall.

The Committee is seeking feedback from member schools and encourages your participation in this process. Written suggestions and proposals on any classification related subjects should be mailed or emailed to the OSAA (kyles@osaa.org) Proposals should use adjusted ADM figures. Any communication received by the OSAA will be shared with all committee members for review and discussion.

The next public meeting of the Classification and Districting Committee will be at 9am on Monday, September 23, 2013, at the OSAA office in Wilsonville. The general format for the meeting will be for the committee to receive public testimony followed by a closed work session.

The Committee will meet once more this school year and will make its final recommendations to the OSAA Executive Board at the October, 2013, Special Classification and Districting Meeting.
