1. 2. Welcome and Introductions.
3. Minutes of September 11, 2018 meeting reviewed and approved.
4. Old Business:
 - a. OHA / OSAA Suicide Prevention – Continued collaborations – Rob Younger, Peter Weber, and Sam Johnson are working on an article that will be published in High School Today regarding collaboration in Oregon on this topic. Cari Wood, Athletic Trainer, Redmond HS and the Redmond HS AD are also contributing and article.
 - b. School Safety Officer Concept – Peter Weber reviewed the discussions with the OSAA Delegate Assembly. Next step would be to determine if we need a formal policy or just a point of contact listed on the OSAA website. Conversation with the OSAA Executive Board will determine the next steps.
 - c. Wrestling – Skin Infections Centralized Reporting – Brad Garrett will explore developing an online data collection tool allowing anyone to report a skin lesion. No names would be used just geographic and classification data.
 - d. Consent to Treat Language – Peter Weber reviewed Arizona’s Consent to Treat language. The committee discussed the merits of Oregon moving towards something like this. There may be some issues with the different types of “consent” provided in the documents parents use to sign up students, or no consent at all. OATS will review the language and come back to the SMAC with a recommendation. Peter to follow up with OSBA on the topic as well.
5. New Business:
 - a. Emergency Action Plan (EAP) Awareness - OSAA/ OACA / OADA / OATS Collaboration – Idea is to create a series of articles outlining the best practices that schools can use to create/improve EAPs. OSAA will be posting and distributing Article #1 to member schools this week. Special thanks to Sam Johnson for taking the lead in putting the articles together.
 - b. NFHSLearn.com – Protecting Students for Abuse Course – Peter Weber provided an overview of the new course on NFHSLearn.com and will be getting information from other states on how they are addressing this topic.
 - c. State Association Concussion Insurance – Peter Weber to discuss with states that have this insurance as to how it’s working, etc.
 - d. Athletic Trainers and Injured Officials – Sent to OAOA for development and draft policy/guidance.
 - e. InvestigateWest – Concussion Report Study – Peter Weber reviewed information about the proposed report. The committee discussed that data related to what types of forms were used and possibly reaching out to schools who aren’t currently using the OSAA-recommended forms.
 - f. Concussion RTP Video – Concerns related to schools following RTP protocols – group believes that a short video explaining RTP best practices could benefit smaller schools with no ATC or other appropriate health care professional. OATS will take lead on developing.
 - g. Vaping/E-Cigarette Concerns – Dr. Koester reviewed information with the committee regarding the increase in vaping by high school students.
 - h. NFHS Injury Surveillance System – High School RIO Summary Reports – Dr. Koester indicated that RIO data will include punt and kickoff injury incidence data this year.

- i. NFHS SMAC October Meeting Update – Dr. Koester provided a short update on NFHS SMAC items, including RIO data, an upcoming epidemiology summit, use of ultrasound for determining body fat % in wrestling, chest protectors in lacrosse, etc.
 - j. HSS / NFHS ACL Prevention Course – Dr. Koester informed the committee about a new NFHSLearn course that will soon be available for free in conjunction with HSS.
 - k. Youth Football Position Statement – The committee reviewed a final draft of the position statement and reiterated its support.
 - l. OATS Championship Coverage – The group discussed insurance coverage in place for ATs and rates for ATs at OSAA Championships as part of a new OSAA/OATS agreement.
 - m. Cross Country State Championships – Brad discussed coverage at this recent event and how we can work together to increase medical staffing in the future.
