SUBJECT:	OSAA State Championship Committee – December 9 Meeting Update

The State Championship Committee for the 2015-2018 four-year time block held its seventh meeting at the OSAA office in Wilsonville on December 9, 2013. The constitutionally mandated purpose of this Committee is to make recommendations to the OSAA Executive Board for adoption in February 2014, regarding championship formats, participation policies, and issues relative to the administration of OSAA State Championships.

Following a review of the charge and the additional questions posed by the OSAA Executive Board, the Committee received public testimony from 14 individuals. The Committee then adjourned to a closed work session to review and discuss the testimony and the written correspondence it had received.

The Committee discussed the following topics:

2A/1A Baseball Proposal: The Committee reviewed a proposal to expand the number of qualifiers into the 2A/1A Baseball State Championships from 16 to 21 teams. The group is not interested in expanding given the projected number of teams in Volleyball and Basketball is similar to 2A/1A Baseball and those sports have 16-team brackets.

Tennis Participation Limitations: The Committee received a request to allow Tennis teams to schedule 18 play dates instead of the current 16 play dates. Coaches have concerns that because of bigger leagues at the large school level the seeding of the tournament would be negatively affected due to fewer non-league matches. The Committee requests additional feedback on the proposed expansion from all schools sponsoring Tennis.

<u>Wrestling Dual Meet Championship</u>: The Committee discussed and does not support adding an additional Championship in Wrestling at this time.

The Committee has reached consensus on the following topics:

<u>Qualifying in Golf and Wrestling:</u> The Committee discussed feedback and testimony received and is currently supporting the attached alignments in Golf and Wrestling at all classification levels.

<u>Allocations in Teams Sports</u>: The Committee continues to support the team sport allocations and bracket sizes in the sports listed in the included chart. The group supports the 4A classification continuing their "play-in" model during the next time block.

<u>Allocations in Individual Sports</u>: The Committee discussed feedback and testimony received and is currently supporting the attached allocations in individual sports at all classification levels.

Team Sports contested in Special Districts: The Committee discussed and supports maintaining current bracket sizes in the following team sports: 3A/2A/1A Boys Soccer (16-team bracket), 3A/2A/1A Girls Soccer (12-team bracket), 2A/1A Baseball (16-team bracket), and 2A/1A Softball (16-team bracket).

Current Recommendations:

<u>1A Football</u>: The Committee <u>supports</u> aligning 1A Football in 4 Special Districts. Four teams will qualify in each Special District to a 16-team bracket. Qualifying procedures will be at the discretion of each Special District. See attached chart for proposed alignments.

<u>Playoff Reimbursement</u>: The Committee <u>supports</u> removing the Per Deim allocations for round trip mileage between 0 and 150 miles to Championship sites. The Mileage reimbursement for this range would continue to stay in place for participating teams.





Volleyball: The Committee **supports** current formats in Volleyball for the next time block at all classification levels.

6A, 5A, 4A Basketball: The Committee supports current formats in Basketball for the next time block at all classification levels.

<u>6A, 5A Basketball</u>: The Committee **<u>supports</u>** gender-specific sites for the 6A, 5A basketball state championships. This support is based on the assumption that tournament sites will be located close enough to allow spectators the opportunity to attend both boys and girls games if a school's boys and girls team are scheduled to play within the same session.

<u>Cheerleading</u>: The Committee <u>supports</u> reformatting the Cheerleading State Championships from a one day-two session event to a one day-one session event.

Dance and Drill: The Committee **supports** reformatting the Dance and Drill State Championships from a four day event to a two day event. See attached tentative schedule.

<u>Standardized Numbered Week Calendar</u>: The Committee supports adopting the NFHS Standardized Calendar to set OSAA State Championship dates.

The Committee discussed adding an additional meeting. If needed, this meeting will be a closed Committee work session to finalize all recommendations that will be forwarded to the OSAA Executive Board at the February meeting.

The Committee welcomes all written proposals regarding any State Championship related subjects. Those submitting proposals need to provide data that would illustrate support from various groups including but not limited to superintendents, principals, athletic directors and coaches. All public testimony should be concise and correspond to the information being presented. Any communication from school representatives regarding Committee issues should be sent to the OSAA rather than to individual Committee members. All written communication received by the OSAA will be shared with every Committee member for review and discussion. Please send emails for the Committee to <u>cindys@osaa.org</u>.

The next meeting of the State Championship Committee will take place on Monday, January 13, 2014 at the OSAA office in Wilsonville. The Committee meeting will begin with an opportunity for public testimony at 9am.
