1. **EMERGENCY PLAN:** In the event of an emergency, natural disaster, fire, war, etc. that forces postponement or cancellation of an OSAA State Championship event, information will be posted to the home page of the OSAA website (<http://www.osaa.org>) and distributed to statewide media outlets. 3. **ADMISSION:** *All persons must have a ticket or pass to enter. Tickets good for all games at Reser Stadium.*

A. **General Admission Tickets:** Adults – \$10 Students – \$5

- 3) VISA / MasterCard sales accepted at both the Southwest Ticket Booths.

The OSAA and GoFan are working together to bring digital ticketing to our State Championship events. The OSAA is very excited to try this new process for our online ticket sales. Spectators will now be able to purchase their tickets online any time including the day of the event and truly skip the lines as they enter.

Cost Structure:

- ADULT Ticket: GoFan / \$10 + \$1.50 Convenience Fee per ticket; Finals Site Box Office / \$10
- STUDENT Ticket: GoFan / \$5 + \$1.25 Convenience Fee per ticket; Finals Site Box Office / \$5

C. **Finals Site:**

- 1) Gate H Ticket Booths open at 10:30am – Gates open at 11am.
- 2) Personal checks and American Express cards are not accepted.
- 3) Cash, VISA / MasterCard accepted at the Southwest Ticket Booths
- 4) Spectators enter via Gate H (South side of stadium under the video board)
 - a) **Bag searches will be performed at all gates.** Your patience and understanding is appreciated.
 - b) Umbrellas may not be used inside the bowl seating area or on the sidelines.
 - c) Gill Coliseum, Prothro Field and the Truax Center will not be open to the public during this event.
- 5) Will Call and Pass entrance located at Gate H ticket booths

4. **LODGING AND VISITOR INFORMATION:** Schools are to make their own arrangements for lodging.

5. **DAMAGE:** Any damage to a facility, including the removal of goal posts, is the responsibility of the school whose students or patrons inflict the damage.

6. **RESER STADIUM SPECTATOR ENTRY POLICY:** No animals other than guide dogs, no outside food or beverages, no weapons of any kind, no hazardous substances, no helium balloons, no smoking, and no signage larger than 8.5"x11". Cameras and videos are allowed, but no tripods.

7. **SPECTATOR SEATING AREAS:** All spectators will enter through Gate H (south end of Reser Stadium)
 - A. **Home Team:** Sections 11 - 14
 - B. **Visiting Team:** Sections 114 – 118
8. **SUPPORT GROUP ENTRY:** Cheer, Band, and Dance teams will enter and exit Reser Stadium through the Field Gate/Player Ramp located next to the Valley Center on the Ralph Miller Drive. An advisor must be present to verify the members of each group. No tickets will be issued to support groups.
9. **SPECTATOR PARKING:** Lots will open at 10am. Reser Stadium will charge \$5 per vehicle between 10am and noon. After noon, parking will increase to \$10 per vehicle. (RV and Campers *may* be charged an additional fee). See attached stadium info for parking instructions.
10. **PORTABLE HEATERS:** Portable heaters are prohibited.
11. **TAILGATING:** Alcohol, open flames and the use of charcoal briquettes are prohibited.
12. **SERVICE ANIMALS:** Trained guide dogs and service animals assisting guests are welcome at OSAA State Championships. All other animals are prohibited. All service animals must remain on a leash or in a harness and be in full control of the handler at all times. Handlers are responsible for any damage or injuries caused by their animals, must properly dispose of waste in appropriate containers and must take appropriate precautions to prevent property damage or injury.

14. **SPECTATOR CONDUCT AT OSAA SANCTIONED EVENTS** (*OSAA Handbook, Executive Board Policies*) (Revised Winter 2015)
 - A. In addition to the general expectations included in the OSAA Constitution, Rule 3, that school officials“...shall take all reasonable measures to ensure that the school’s students and supporters maintain a sportsmanlike attitude toward all events...” the following specific expectations regarding spectator conduct at all OSAA sanctioned events, including regular and post season competition, are provided:
 - B. All cheers, comments and actions shall be in direct support of one’s team. No cheers, comments or actions shall be directed at one’s opponent or at contest officials. Some examples of inappropriate conduct or actions that are not permitted are: turning backs, holding up newspapers or jeering at cheerleaders during opposing team introductions; disrespecting players by name, number or position; negative cheers or chants; throwing objects on the floor.
 - C. Spectators are not permitted to have signs or banners (larger than 8 ½ by 11 inches), confetti, balloons or glass containers. “Fathead” type items are considered signs and shall not be larger than 8 ½ by 11 inches. Spectators are required to wear shirts.
 - D. Spectators are not permitted to have artificial noisemakers. Some examples of artificial noisemakers are Thunder Stix, cowbells, clappers and air horns.
 - E. Spectators shall not be permitted to use vulgar/offensive or racially/culturally insensitive language. Spectators shall not be permitted to engage in any racially / culturally insensitive action.
 - F. Spectators who fail to comply with Association or site management spectator conduct expectations may be expelled from the contest.
15. **STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS – VIDEOTAPING** (*OSAA Handbook, Executive Board Policies*)

Any school or spectator may videotape state championships from the stands, providing they do not obstruct the view of others or require extra space. Use of a tripod in the stands is prohibited for safety reasons. When a school films its own team during a state championship, the official school representative will be granted the privilege of filming from the designated area established by the OSAA. NOTE: Videotaping or filming is for private use only. Televising, including live or delayed broadcasts and cable, is prohibited unless a contract is signed with the OSAA.
16. **AWARDS:** Team trophies will be presented immediately following each championship game. Medals will be distributed to the athletic director of each school following each championship game.
 - A. **Trophies:** Trophies will be presented to the champion and second place teams in each classification. A trophy will also be sent to each semifinal team.
 - B. **Medals:** The following number of medals will be presented to the champion and second place teams in each classification: 5A – 55; 4A – 44; 3A – 36; 2A – 36; 1A – 27.
 - C. **Moda Health Player of the Game:** One player from each team in each classification’s semifinal and final games will be recognized as that team’s Moda Health Player of the Game. The winners will be announced over the PA and on the OSAA Radio Network broadcast at the conclusion of each classification’s semifinal and final games. A certificate and commemorative gift from Moda Health will be mailed to the student’s athletic director shortly after the event.

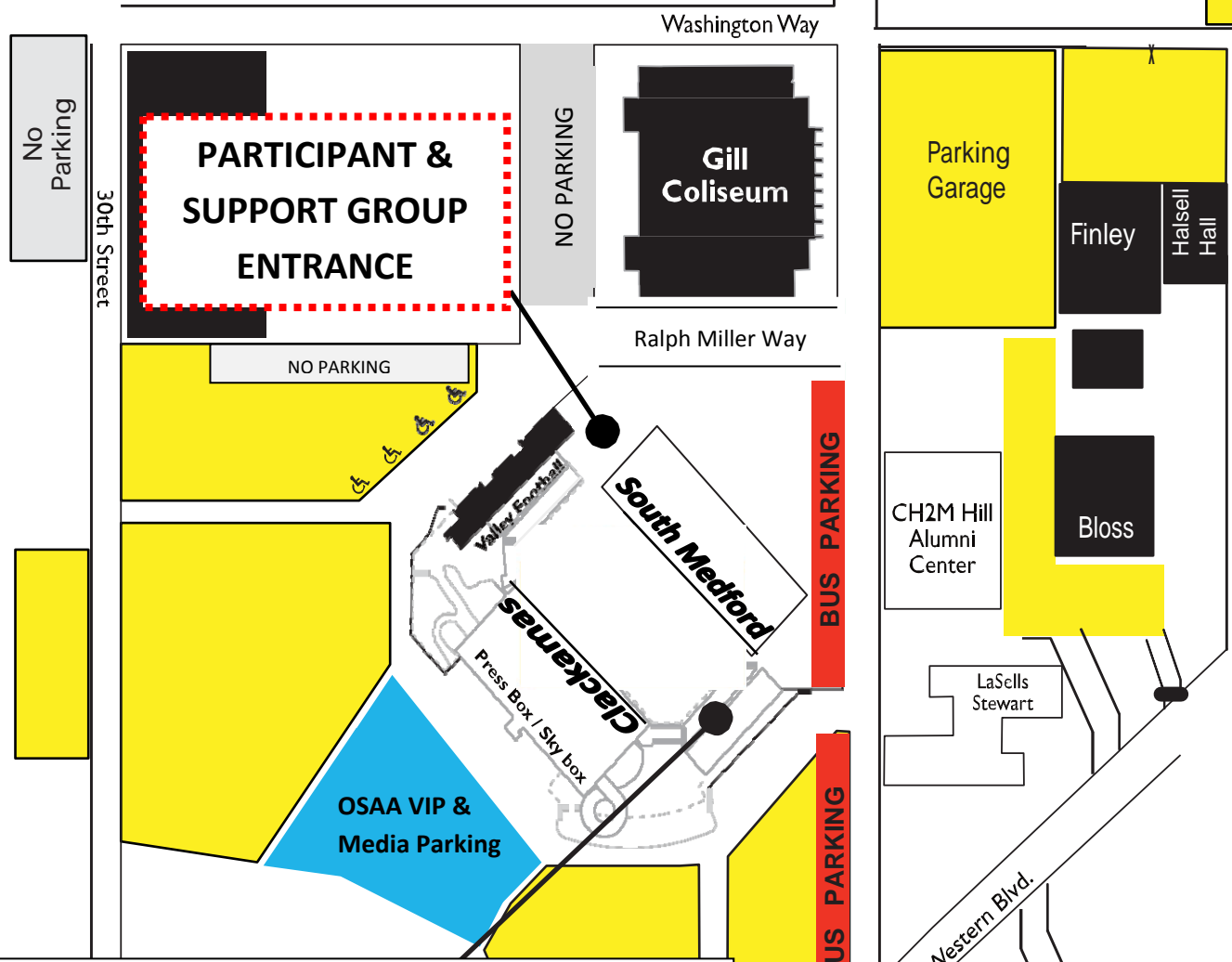
