### **COACHES & OFFICIALS NFHS RULE INFORMATION**

Common rule misapplications:

- 1. Rule 9-3-3a / Rule 9-5-8
  - If a ball passes completely beyond the plane of the centerline extension it should be whistled and ruled dead, out of bounds. There is no pursuit rule in NFHS volleyball.
  - A player may cross the centerline extension but must play the ball before it completely crosses the vertical plane of the net extended.
- 2. Rule 5-2 Numbers are no longer to be given on centerline violations as in net violations.
- 3. Rule 9-6-3 "A player shall not contact a ball which is completely on the opponent's side of the net unless the contact is a legal block."
  - A ball may never be attacked if it is completely on the opponent's side of the net.
- 4. Rule 9-6-4 Blocking a ball
  - Blocking a ball completely on the opponent's side of the net may be done legally if:
    - Attacking team has completed 3 hits;
    - o Attacking team has had the opportunity to complete the attack or, in the referee's judgment, directs the ball toward the opponent's court;
    - o Ball is falling near the net and, in the referee's judgment, no legal member of the attacking team could make a play on the ball.

Note: Officials should take into account a girl's possible athletic ability, she may be able to come out of nowhere and make a great save on the ball.

At the commissioners meeting this past August we reviewed video from state and as a group highlighted very important mechanics and signals all R2's should know. Correct net sequence, correct time out protocols, and deciding set protocols were discussed.
