Libero Clarifications Per Rules 9-5-6 & Rule 10-4

1. A libero cannot attack a ball completely above the height of the net from anywhere on the court.
2. A libero cannot set a ball (overhand) on or in front of the attack line to an attacker who makes contact with the ball completely above the height of the net.
3. The libero or her teammates must be in a solid colored jersey. We are still having jersey issues. Do not send a team to the playoffs in an illegal jersey. They will not be allowed to play in an illegal jersey.
4. An illegal libero replacement caught prior to whistle and signal for serve is a YUD (Yellow Unnecessary Delay Card) but after is illegal alignment.

Reminder on Net Play

No player can attack a ball completely on the other side of the net.

National Anthem Protocols

Please see page 69-70 of the Officials Manual to follow the National Anthem protocols and brush up prior to playoffs. Line judges do carry their flags across the court with them and the book shows the path the line judge's walk to their corners. Check out the new Zoom video on line judging and be ready to look sharp at the playoffs.
