Subject: Volleyball Uniforms

It has been brought to my attention that we have a number of schools wearing illegal uniforms. The main problem, a new issue this year, is spandex or other uniform bottoms that have multiple logos on the waistband. Please note the following and be aware that this is not a new rule or a previous rule that has been changed:

2012-13 NFHS VOLLEYBALL RULES BOOK

Rule 4.2 / Pages 17-18

ART. 7... Any visible garment (t-shirt, body suits and other similar garments) worn underneath the uniform top shall be unadorned and of a single, solid color that is similar in color to the predominant color of the uniform top. As per NFHS rules, a <u>single</u>, visible manufacturer's logo and /or single school name or insignia no more than 2½ inches are permitted on the undergarment.

ART. 9... A <u>single</u> partial/whole manufacturer's logo/trademark/reference, no more than 2½ square inches with no dimension more than 2½ inches, is permitted on each piece of the uniform provided placement does not interfere with the visibility of the player's number.

Please make sure that your teams are in legal uniforms. Best of luck as your season continues and do not hesitate to contact me with questions. Thank you, as always, for your assistance.
