OSAA 4A Football Rotation History

Procedures established in 1993-94 when nine districts were formed.

1. Nine Athletic Districts
2. Each district has three representative
3. Each district with eight or more schools shall receive a 4th representative, except that if this generates more than 32 teams, a rotation plan shall be established to select additional teams.
