Peter,

Here is my version of the proposals. I would leave 1A-5A unchanged. Playoffs and such would remain similar to last two years. I just reconfigured the 6A to have bigger leagues and to create good competition. I based all my numbers from the Draft Proposal #1 that came out just before Christmas with one exception. Our school is in declining enrollment due to school district realignment and the economy, we are currently at the 1450 mark and going down. The classification divisions would use these numbers; 6A (1521+); 5A (1520-851); 4A (850-401) and on down to what ever the others were set at. Thanks, and if you have questions please get back to me. One other thing about my proposal. Leagues and divisions can service each other for the non league components as well as playing other classifications if so chosen. One of the the issues that may come up is finding non-league for basketball and baseball, because of the amount of dates/games to fill. Football will only need to find 3 non-league games, whereas baseball and basketball will need to find more. One solution is to play three game series with league opponents and to play home and home with non-league games like we do currently in league contests. So non-league essentially is playing a school 2 games (home/home), that would fill two dates.

6A Super-League Proposal

1A – 5A Classification Format:

1. Will be derived from OSAA Proposal #1 (league sizes and school size & #'s)
2. Bend would be 5A based on inaccurate #'s first released.

6A Classification Format:

1. Play 9 game schedule
2. Play 5 division games *{Emerald Valley will play 6} {Redmond moves to 5A in 2012}
3. Play 3 non-league *{Emerald Valley will play 2}
4. Each league gives 5 playoff spots with a rotating 6th place.
5. 16- 24 team tournament- many have *byes* or *pig tails* to match other classifications. This would be up to the Championship Committee.
6. 9th Game is set for league championship and playoff spots/seeds.
