Allow each league to determine playoff representatives at each level (indicated in parenthesis) and league schedules to accommodate for geographic differences. Each sport will have a 16-team bracket.

There are only two 2A football schools in District 6 and no 2A football schools in District 2. Football may require special districting or a reallocation of football playoff spot to create the field of 16. Moving Riddle and Glendale into District 5 for football and allowing for two playoffs spots would work. I would then rotate the remaining 3 football playoff spots between District 1, District 3, District 4, District 5, and District 6 on a yearly basis to create the field of 16.
