



## David's Ball's proposal for 2010-2014 realignment (Class 4A model)

### Class 4A (8 leagues...60 schools)

- My Class 4A model calls for most of the PIL to drop into Class 3A, while the four largest schools are divided into various. The three major metro-area leagues are strong with nine teams apiece, while the Southern and Central leagues remain small at only five teams — part of the cost of living in a remote area of the state. I would allow these leagues to vote to join forces to form one large 10-team group if they preferred.

### Class 3A (8 leagues...59 schools)

- My 3A classification has a pair of metro leagues — one the PIL with the addition of Parkrose, and another that groups teams from Milwaukie and the surrounding area. The largest league in this group is the Skyline, which groups 10 schools from the South. A coastal league calls for Taft and Seaside to play up slightly, while Hood River lands in a revamped Intermountain League. Including The Dalles and Madras should cut travel somewhat, and LaPine would be the only trip south of Bend.

### Class 2A (8 leagues...62 schools)

- The largest group in Class 2A would be a cluster of 10 coastal schools, located mostly in the North, but also stretching into the mid-coastal range to include Toledo and Waldport. The new Lewis & Clark league would gather nine metro-area schools including Corbett. A trio of Medford-area schools, Bonanza, Chiloquin and Lost River, have shown a desire to "play up" giving the South a solid eight-team league.

### Class 1A (12 leagues...105 schools)

- This is traditionally the largest classification in the state, gathering all of the small schools spread throughout the remote regions of the state along with a number of small private schools in the metro-area. Teams are clustered by region with groups near Salem, Medford, Pendleton and Bend. The smallest leagues are seven-team groupings for the Northwest League (coastal and westside schools) and the Old Oregon League (eastern edge of the state).
