

Hyrid 4A/ 4B Proposal

Proposal:

4A - 9 leagues, 8-10 teams in a league

- 2 divisions in each league
- schools play a complete league schedule
- separate 4A and 4B playoffs by division

3A - 7 leagues, 5-9 teams in a league, no divisions

2A - Return to '05-'06 alignment adjusted with updated enrollment figures

1A - Remains the same with alignment adjusted with updated enrollment figures

Proposed Highlights:

- 2 year cycle for divisions, and leagues remain in 4 year time block
- Individual sports with district meets will not divide into divisions
- Geographic proximity is the overwhelming major criteria for placing schools in leagues

Major Concerns Resolved:

- more leagues
- league size increaseds
- easier non-league scheduling
- many rivalries restored
- all financial factors improved
- less travel time and distance
- increased spectator following
- less class time missed
- easier frosh and JV scheduling
- likely participation increase
- playoff parity by divisions

Conclusion:

- same concerns reiterated by over 20 presenters
- this hybrid 4A-4B proposal answers and resolves each issue

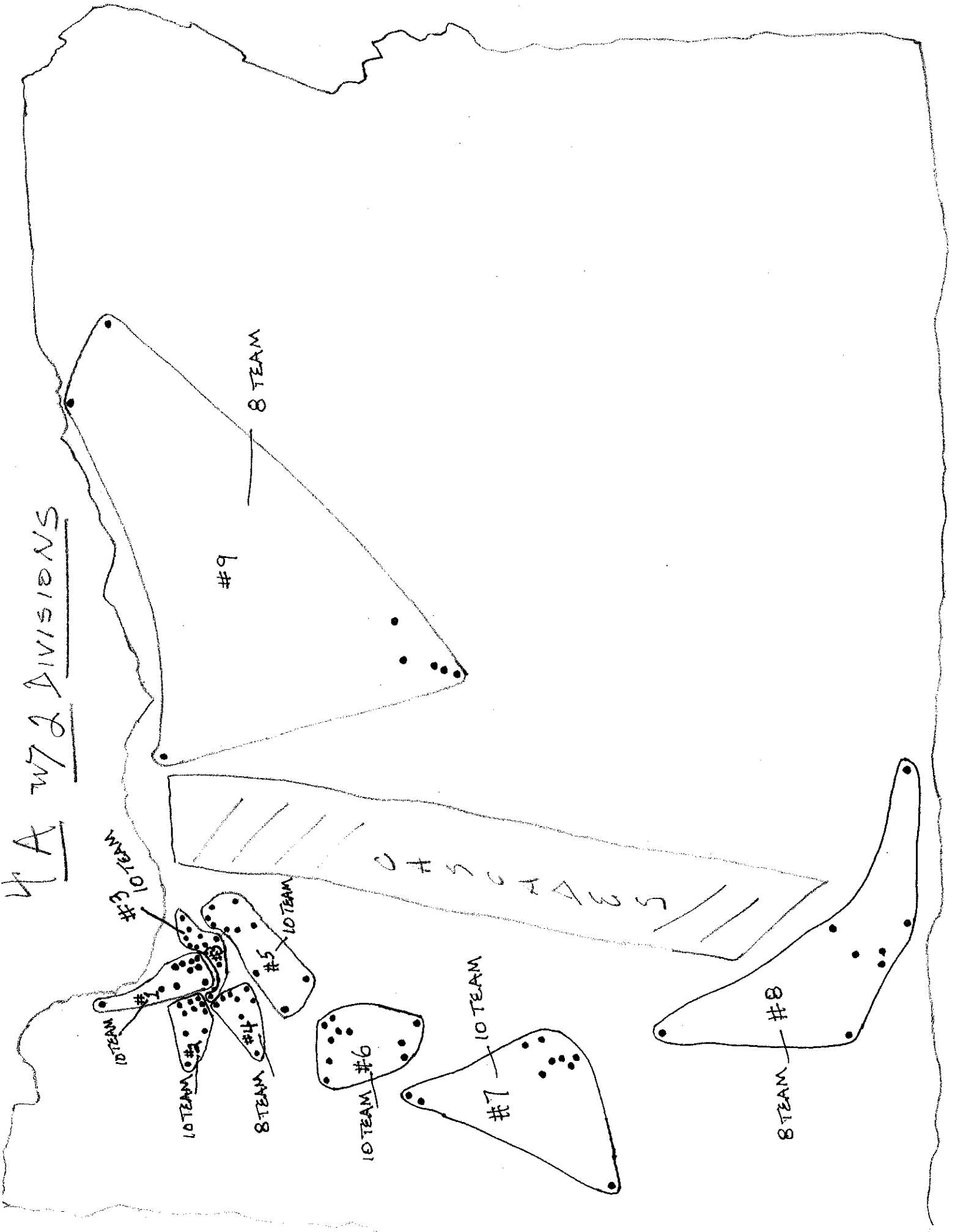

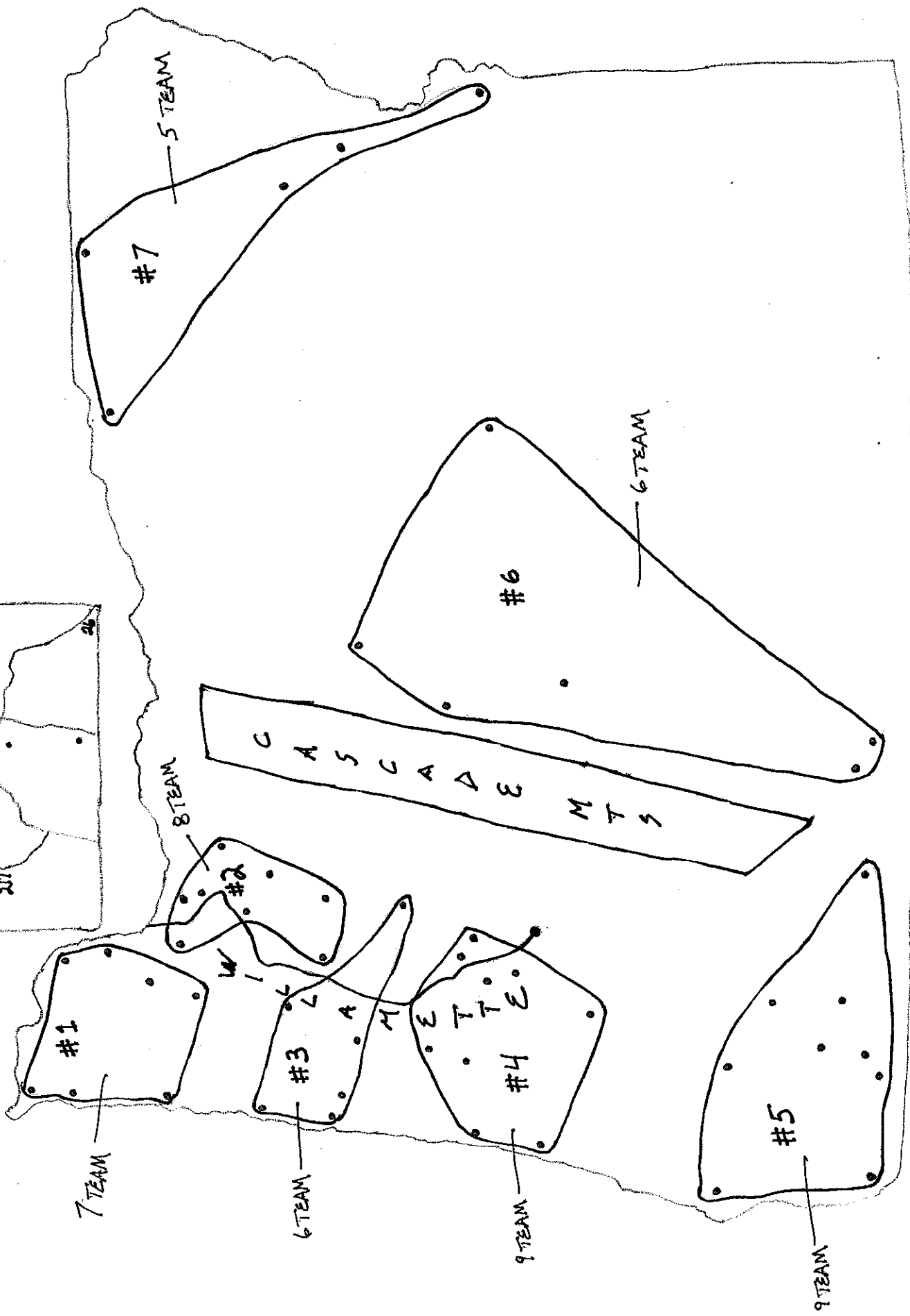
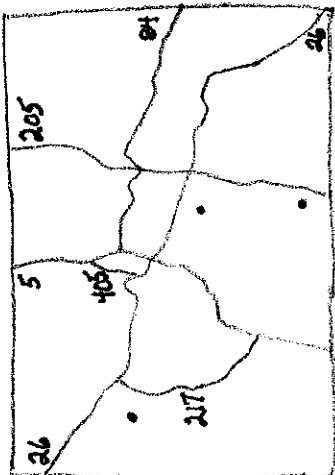
