Registration:

- Every official will need to create a new profile when attempting to log-in to the NFHS testing site the first time – this process takes about 1 min
- Keep your username and password in a safe place for future reference
- Leave State ID number blank – not needed for OSAA purposes
- IMPERATIVE that each participant lists their local association affiliation when developing their profile.

Testing Detail – All Certification Sports

- 100 question exam – questions in random order
- Score and full results will be reported immediately after exam is submitted.
- Participants are allowed 5 sittings in order to complete the exam
- Participants are allowed to take the exam a maximum of 3 times to achieve desired score. *Note: Once a score of 90% or above is achieved the exam is locked.*
- Passing score is 75% for certification – 90% score is required to officiate State Championship contests in all sports (Note: Round 1 through Championship game)

Results Reporting – All Certification Sports

- Scores will be reported to the OSAA office weekly
- Scores will be sent to Commissioner of each local association weekly. It is the responsibility of the Commissioner to enter individual scores into Officials.net for verification purposes.
