RE: Volleyball Line Judges – Required Use of Flags for 2009 Season

NFHS Volleyball rule 5-8-4 states “by state high school association adoption, line judges may use flags.” OSAA has adopted this policy, which will go into effect this fall, 2009. All OSAA volleyball matches must have line judges equipped with RED flags, varsity and sub-varsity.

Your local sporting goods supplier can provide these for you. I have included an example at the bottom of this memo. Reminder that each line judge will use one (1) flag so it will take two (2) flags per match/court. If you host tournament(s), please make sure that you purchase enough flags to cover each court during tournament play.

There has been a tremendous amount of interest in this and it will greatly enhance the match. Please do not hesitate to contact me with questions.
