4. **SPECTATOR CONDUCT AT OSAA SANCTIONED EVENTS:** *(OSAA Handbook, Executive Board Policies)*

“In addition to the general expectations included in the OSAA Constitution, Rule 3, that school officials “...shall take all reasonable measures to ensure that the school’s students and supporters maintain a sportsmanlike attitude toward all events...” the following specific expectations regarding spectator conduct **at all OSAA sanctioned events, including regular and post season competition**, are provided: *(Revised Fall 2008)*

  - A. **All cheers, comments and actions shall be in direct support of one’s team. No cheers, comments or actions shall be directed at one’s opponent or at contest officials. Some examples of inappropriate conduct or actions that are not permitted are: turning backs, holding up newspapers or jeering at cheerleaders during opposing team introductions; disrespecting players by name, number or position; negative cheers or chants; throwing objects on the floor. (Revised Fall 2008)**
  - B. Spectators are not permitted to have signs or banners (larger than 8 ½ by 11 inches), confetti, balloons or glass containers. Spectators are required to wear shirts.
  - C. Spectators are not permitted to have artificial noisemakers. Some examples of artificial noisemakers are Thunder Stix, cowbells, clappers and air horns.
  - D. Spectators shall not be permitted to use vulgar/offensive **or racially/culturally insensitive** language. **Spectators shall not be permitted to engage in any racially / culturally insensitive action. (Revised Fall 2008)**

5. **STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS – VIDEOTAPING** (*OSAA Handbook, Executive Board Policies*): “Any school or spectator may videotape state championships from the stands, providing they do not obstruct the view of others or require extra space. Use of a tripod in the stands is prohibited for safety reasons. When a school films its own team during a state championship, the official school representative will be granted the privilege of filming from the designated area established by the OSAA. NOTE: Videotaping or filming is for private use only. Televising, including live or delayed broadcasts and cable, is prohibited unless a contract is signed with the OSAA.”
6. **STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS – RADIO, TELEVISION AND INTERNET BROADCASTS** (*OSAA Handbook, Executive Board Policies*): “The OSAA owns the rights to and coordinates any radio, television and/or Internet broadcasts for state championship events, first round through championship final. Media outlets that wish to broadcast any state championship event must contact the OSAA for permission and/or to negotiate a rights fee well in advance of the event. The OSAA shall contact the host school athletic director if a media outlet has been granted permission to broadcast an early round event. If the OSAA has not contacted the host school athletic director to confirm that permission has been granted, the broadcast shall not be allowed. It shall be the responsibility of the media outlet to make all necessary arrangements with the host school athletic director and to pay for any phone line charges or installation fees for any early round event. The OSAA will coordinate arrangements with media outlets at all final sites. (Revised Fall 2007)”
7. **PARKING:**
  - a. **Team Buses and Vans:** Clearly marked school district buses and vans will be able to park in the Benton lot, located directly north of Memorial Coliseum (between Coliseum and NE Broadway Blvd.) on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday on a space availability basis. This lot is not available for private cars and personal vans.
  - b. **Spectator Parking:** PLEASE PRINT THIS FLYER AND DISTRIBUTE TO ATHLETES, PARENTS, BOOSTERS, ETC. **IMPORTANT NOTE:** Please inform your parents and fans that the PARKING LOT WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE FOR RV's, MOTOR HOMES, OR OTHER OVERNIGHT CAMPING.

Championship and consolation brackets will be continuously updated during the championships. Team standings for each classification will be posted at the end of each evening. Please instruct your fans and local media to go there for results.
9. **AWARDS:** Team trophies will be presented at the conclusion of the event on Saturday evening. Individual medals will be presented to the top placers in each classification following the championship match in each weight class.
  - a. **Trophies:** Champion through fourth place trophies will be presented to the top teams in each classification.
  - b. **Medals:** Individual medals will be presented to the top eight finishers in each weight class at the 6A-5A-4A classifications, the top six finishers at the 3A classification and the top four finishers at the 2A/1A classification.
  - c. **Qwest Athlete of the Meet** – The top scoring wrestler in each classification will be recognized as that classification's Qwest Athlete of the Meet. In the event of a tie, the award will go to the wrestler whose team placed highest overall. The winners will be announced over the PA and will receive a certificate and commemorative gift from Qwest the week following the championships. The certificate and gift will be mailed to the student's athletic director.

- ◆ **DAY OF EVENT PARKING:** Parking is available on-site based on availability. Parking rates are subject to change based on the Rose Quarter event schedule.  
SUBJECT TO AVAILABILITY – in/out privileges will be allowed as noted.
  - THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 26 –  
SUBJECT TO AVAILABILITY – \$6 with in/out privileges allowed all day.
  - FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 27 –  
SUBJECT TO AVAILABILITY – \$6 with in/out privileges until 5:30 pm.  
\$13 after 5:30 pm. No in/out privileges after 5:30 pm.
  - SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 28 –  
SUBJECT TO AVAILABILITY – \$6 until 6:30 pm with in/out privileges until 6:30 pm.  
\$10 after 6:30 pm. \$12 with in/out privileges after 6:30 pm.
- ◆ IT IS RECOMMENDED that you leave your car in the Parking Garage BETWEEN SESSIONS.  
OR
- ◆ BOOK A HOTEL CLOSE TO THE MAX / FARELESS SQUARE LINE AND RIDE MAX FOR FREE.  
OR
- ◆ USE THE MAX LIGHTRAIL TO GET TO THE COLISEUM. There are three Smart Park garages in “Fareless Square”: 730 SW 10<sup>th</sup> and Morrison, 620 SW 4th and 122 NW 10<sup>th</sup>. Smart Park garage rates are as follows:

\$1.25 per hour for the first four hours  
\$3 per hour after four hours  
Maximum charge is \$12  
After 6:00 p.m., the charge is \$2 on weekdays
