DURING DISTRICT MEET

1. **STATE CHAMPIONSHIP INFORMATION DISTRIBUTION:** The State Championship Information must be downloaded from the OSAA website, www.osaa.org/activities/bqf. Tight timelines dictate distribution of materials for the state championship must be done at the district meet site. PLEASE ensure that each coach in your district receives your classification's AD & Coach Information at the District Meet. Your assistance in distributing this information is very much appreciated.
2. **CHEATING AND INCORRECT SCORING:** Please remind each participant that it is their responsibility to protect themselves, their team and the entire field from cheating or incorrect scoring. It is their job to keep their score and the scores of their playing partners. Cheating is dealt with very seriously and may result in disqualification. There will be no hesitation to put a marker on groups if it proves to be necessary. Integrity is a key component to golf, and we expect each player to hold true to those standards.
3. **iWANAMAKER SCORING REQUIRED:** All District and Regional Meets need to be scored with iWanamaker. Link to iWanamaker Scoring directions here [iWanamaker Scoring Directions](#).

POST DISTRICT MEET

1. CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFICATIONS:

A. 6A Boys and Girls:

- 1) **Team Automatic Qualifiers:** Each league will determine one team that directly qualifies to the OSAA State Championship. PIL – 1; Metro - 1; Pacific – 1; Mt. Hood – 1; Three Rivers – 1; Central Valley – 1; Southwest – 1
- 2) **Individual Automatic Qualifiers:** Each league will determine two individual qualifiers to the OSAA State Championship. The two qualifiers are golfers who are not on the qualifying team.
- 3) **At-Large Regional Team Qualifiers:** Each league will qualify 3 teams (2nd, 3rd and 4th place teams) to the regional tournament. Each region will determine teams from their regional tournament to the OSAA State Championship. Regional tournament pairings will consist of and the number of teams:

PIL & Metro & Pacific – 3; Mt. Hood & Three Rivers – 2; Central Valley & Southwest – 2.

- 4) **At-Large Regional Individual Qualifiers:** Each league will determine four individuals that will qualify for the regional tournament. Each region will determine the individuals from their regional tournament to the OSAA State Championship. The qualifiers are golfers who are not on the qualifying team. Regional tournament pairings will consist of and the number of individuals:
 PIL & Metro & Pacific – 3; Mt. Hood & Three Rivers – 2; Central Valley & Southwest – 2.
- 5) **Ties:** Any ties for final team or individual qualification spots shall be broken by the Special District prior to submitting the official state championship entry to the OSAA.
- B. **5A Boys and Girls:** Note: Allocations listed below subject to change due to the number of teams / individuals competing at special district tournaments.
- 1) **Team Automatic Qualifiers:** Each league will determine one team that directly qualifies to the OSAA State Championship. Northwest Oregon – 1; Midwestern – 1; Mid-Willamette – 1; Intermountain – 1.
- 2) **Individual Automatic Qualifiers:** Each league will determine two individual qualifiers to the OSAA State Championship. The two qualifiers are golfers who are not on the qualifying team.
- 3) **At-Large Regional Team Qualifiers:** Each league will qualify 3 teams (2nd, 3rd, and 4th place teams) to the regional tournament. Each region will determine two teams from their regional tournament to the OSAA State Championship. Regional tournament pairings will consist of - Special District 1 – Northwest Oregon & Intermountain; Special District 2 – Mid-Willamette & Midwestern.
- 4) **At-Large Regional Individual Qualifiers:** Each league will determine four individuals that will qualify for the regional tournament. Each Special District will determine the five individuals from their regional tournament to the OSAA State Championship. The qualifiers are golfers who are not on the qualifying team. The regional tournament paring will consist of and the number of individuals.
- 5) **Ties:** Any ties for final team or individual qualification spots shall be broken by the Special District prior to submitting the official state championship entry to the OSAA.
- C. **4A Boys:** Note: Allocations listed below subject to change due to the number of teams / individuals competing at Special District events.
- 1) **Team Automatic Qualifiers:** The top allocated number of teams from the special district tournament.
 Special District 1 – 4; Special District 2 – 4 Not before 9am; Special District 3 – 2; Special District 4 – 2.
- 2) **Individual Automatic Qualifiers:** The top 5 individuals from each Special District must be in the Top 5 overall to qualify for the OSAA State Championships.
- 3) **Ties:** Any ties for final team or individual qualification spots shall be broken by the special district prior to submitting the official state championship entry to the OSAA.
- D. **4A/3A/2A/1A Girls:** Note: Allocations listed below subject to change due to the number of teams / individuals competing at special district tournaments.
- 1) **Team Automatic Qualifiers:** The top allocated number of teams from the special district tournament.
 Special District 1 – 4; Special District 2 – 2; Special District 3 – 4; Special District 4 – 2.
- 2) **Individual Automatic Qualifiers:** The top 5 individuals from each Special District must be in the Top 5 overall to qualify for the State Championships.
- 3) **Ties:** Any ties for final team or individual qualification spots shall be broken by the Special District prior to submitting the official state championship entry to the OSAA.
- E. **3A/2A/1A Boys:** Note: Allocations listed below subject to change due to the number of teams / individuals competing at special district events.
- 1) **Team Automatic Qualifiers:** The top allocated number of teams from the special district tournament.
 Special District 1 – 3; Special District 2 – 3; Special District 3 – 3; Special District 4 – 3.
- 2) **Individual Automatic Qualifiers:** The top 5 individuals from each Special District must be in the Top 5 overall to qualify for the OSAA State Championships.
- 3) **Ties:** Any ties for final team or individual qualification spots shall be broken by the Special District prior to submitting the official state championship entry to the OSAA.

2. **STATE CHAMPIONSHIP ENTRY FORM:** www.osaa.org/activities/bqf

Entries must be submitted no later than 10pm, Tuesday, May 7. Submit your entry following the steps below. Contact Missy Smith at 503.682.6722 x227 (office), 503.709.4867 (cell) with questions or if you do not have the password.

Step 1: Go to the OSAA website, www.osaa.org/activities/bqf. Click on the "State Championship Entry Form"

Step 2: Choose your district from the drop-down menu.

Step 3: Enter your password and select Edit Form.

Step 4: Enter your Meet Director Information.

Step 5: Enter the number of Varsity participants at your district / regional meet.

Step 6: Select the school name of your District Champion and District 2nd Place team, enter contact information for each coach and list the first name, last name, year in school and Round 1 and Round 2 scores of each member of that qualifying team. **NOTE: Please list players in order of where they will play in the first Round of the State Championship. Teams will tee off in order from #1 through #5 for the first Round.**

Step 7: Select the school name of each of your individual qualifiers, enter contact information for each coach and list the first name, last name, year in school and Round 1 and round 2 scores for each.

Step 8: Click "Submit" – The form will check for missing information and will not submit until the information is complete. When the form has been submitted you will be sent a confirmation email. The completed entry form can be modified and re-submitted until 10pm on Tuesday, May 7.

3. **PRE-STATE CHAMPIONSHIP POSTING TIMELINE:**

A. Tee Times: www.osaa.org/activities/bqf

Tee times for team and individual qualifiers will be posted on the OSAA website by 4pm on Wednesday, May 8.

B. District Meet Directors AND coaches of qualifying teams and individuals are responsible for checking the accuracy of the entry information. Please check your entries for correct spelling of participant's name, year in school, and school name, as this information will appear the same way on the scorecards, score sheets, and in the championship results unless corrected.

5. **STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS – INDIVIDUAL SPORT SUBSTITUTIONS** (OSAA Handbook, Executive Board Policies)

A. The following shall be the policy for substitutions in individual sport State Championship events. All individuals who are substitutes for individual qualifiers must have participated in a District or Special District Meet.

C. **Golf**

(Revised Winter 2019)

1) **Individuals:**

a) **6A and 5A Boys and Girls:** If an individual qualifier drops out of the state championship by 4pm two business days prior (**Thursday, May 9**) to the state championship, the district or regional (depending on how the individual originally qualified) may substitute the next eligible individual qualifier not a member of a qualifying team. The district must notify the OSAA office of any such substitution by 4pm two business days prior (**Thursday, May 9**) to the state championship.

b) **4A Boys, 4A/3A/2A/1A Girls, 3A/2A/1A Boys:** Substitutions for individual qualifiers not members of qualifying team are not permitted.

2) **Team:** Substitutions on qualified teams may be made up to one hour prior to the start of each round of the state championship. A team may enter a maximum of five participants with its top four finishers counting toward team standings.

Notification - Schools are required to notify the OSAA prior to the start of a state championship event if a student entered in the event will be unable to compete for any reason. Failure by a school to notify the OSAA prior to the start of a state championship event may result in a fine and/or other penalties being assessed to that school. **The district must notify the OSAA office, Missy Smith at 503.682.6722 x227 (office), 503.709.4867 (cell).**

6. **OSAA Hard Card: Please review and distribute the OSAA Hard Card (attached) to the district teams.**

The Rules of Golf as approved by the United States Golf Association and the R&A govern play and where applicable, by the following Local Rules and Terms of the Competition. Complete text of Rules and Local Rules may be found in the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf, effective January 2024. Unless otherwise noted, the penalty for breach of a Local Rule is the general penalty. See Notice to Players for additional Local Rules and Terms of the Competition. If a player in a team competition breaches a Rule that results in disqualification, the effect will be to disqualify the player for that round only. Exception: serious misconduct, in which it is up to the Committee.

Please note that while in some earlier competitions this year the Local Rule for Alternative to Stroke and Distance for Ball Lost or Out of Bounds may have been used, the Local Rule is not in effect for any competition covered by this document.

1. **OUT OF BOUNDS:** Defined by the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of the white stakes or fence posts. Out of bounds may also be defined by white lines.
2. **PENALTY AREAS:** When a penalty area is defined on only one side, it extends to infinity. When a penalty area is connected to the out of bounds edge, the penalty area extends to and coincides with out of bounds.
3. **GROUND UNDER REPAIR:**
 - A. Defined by white lines. Ground under repair also includes French drains, which are trenches filled with rocks or stones and newly trenched areas, including grass-covered cables. See Temporary Power Lines and Cables.
 - B. Ground under repair may include areas of unusual damage, including areas where spectators or other traffic has combined with wet conditions to affect materially the ground surface, but only when so declared by an authorized member of the Committee. When immediately adjacent to an obstruction, such an area is part of the obstruction.
4. **IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS:** Include plastic bumpers on roads and paths, and mats secured to the ground with spikes when the bumpers or mats cover cables.
5. **IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS CLOSE TO PUTTING GREENS:** Model Local Rule F-5.1 as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect.
6. **RELIEF FROM SEAMS OF CUT TURF:** Model Local Rule F-7 as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect. If a player's ball lies in or touches a seam of cut turf or a seam interferes with the player's area of intended swing: (a) Ball in the General Area. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b. (b) Ball on Putting Green. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1d. But interference does not exist if the seam only interferes with the player's stance.
7. **WHITE-LINED AREAS TYING INTO ARTIFICIALLY SURFACED ROADS AND PATHS:** White-lined areas of ground under repair and the artificially surfaced roads, paths or other identified obstructions that they are connected to are a single abnormal course condition when taking relief under Rule 16.1.
8. **WOOD CHIPS AND MULCH:** Are loose impediments.
9. **INTEGRAL OBJECTS:** Include objects, such as cables, rods, wires or wrappings, when closely attached to trees and boundary objects, and artificial walls and pilings when located in penalty areas or in or adjacent to bunkers, and bunker liners. An exposed bunker liner may be treated as ground under repair, but interference does not exist if the liner interferes only with the player's stance.
10. **BALL DEFLECTED BY POWER LINE:** Model Local Rule E-11 as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect. If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball hit a permanent power line, tower, or a wire or pole supporting a power line during the play of a hole, the player must replay the stroke by playing the original ball or another ball from the spot where that stroke was made (see Rule 14.6).
11. **TEMPORARY POWER LINES AND CABLES:** Model Local Rule F-22 as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect.
12. **TEMPORARY IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS:** Model Local Rule F-23 as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect.
13. **LIST OF CONFORMING DRIVER HEADS:** Model Local Rule G-1 as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect.

14. **LIST OF CONFORMING GOLF BALLS:** Model Local Rule G-3 as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect.
15. **TRANSPORTATION:** Model Local Rule G-6 as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect. During the round, a player must not ride on any form of motorized transportation except as authorized or later approved by the Committee (a player may always ride to and from where a previous stroke was made).
16. **PROHIBITING USE OF CERTAIN TYPES OF SHOES:** Model Local Rule G-7as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect.
17. **PROHIBITING USE OF AUDIO AND VIDEO DEVICES:** Model Local Rule G-8 as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect. Rule 4.3a (4) is modified in this way: During a round, a player must not listen to or watch content of any nature on a personal audio or video device.
18. **USE OF CADDIE PROHIBITED:** Model Local Rule H-1.1 as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect. A player must not have a caddie during the round.
19. **RESTRICTIONS ON PRACTICE BEFORE OR BETWEEN ROUNDS:** Model Local Rule I-1.1 as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect. Rule 5.2b is modified in this way: a player must not practice on the competition course before or between rounds. Penalty for breach of Local Rule, see Rule 5.2
20. **RESTRICTION ON PRACTICE OR TESTING BETWEEN THE PLAY OF TWO HOLES:** Model Local Rule I-2 as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect. A player must not make any practice stroke on or near the putting green of the hole just completed or test the surface of that putting green by rubbing the putting green or rolling a ball or make any practice stroke on or near any practice green.
21. **STOPPING AND RESUMING PLAY:**
 - A. A suspension of play for a dangerous situation will be signaled by one prolonged note of a siren or horn. All other suspensions will be signaled by three consecutive notes of a siren or horn. In either case, resumption of play will be signaled by two short notes of a siren or horn. See Rule 5.7b. **Note:** All practice areas are closed during an immediate suspension for a dangerous situation until the Committee has declared them open. Players who practice on closed practice areas will be asked to stop practicing; failure to stop practicing might result in disqualification.
 - B. When play is suspended by the Committee, if the players in a match or group are between the play of two holes, they must not resume play until the Committee has ordered a resumption of play. If they have started play of a hole, they may discontinue play immediately or continue play of the hole, provided they do so without delay. If the players choose to continue play of the hole, they are permitted to discontinue play before completing it. Before lifting the ball, the player must mark its position. The players must resume play when the Committee has ordered a resumption of play. Resumptions of play will be signaled by two short notes of a siren or horn.
22. **DRESS CODE:** Players must adhere to the dress codes set out by each hosting course.
23. **ADVICE:** Each team may appoint one person who may give advice to members of that team. Advice givers must be identified to the Committee before giving advice. Advice may only be given to a player between the play of two holes or during suspensions of play but may not be given while a player is playing a hole. The penalty for each breach of this Rule by an advice giver is the General Penalty added to the player's score who is involved.
24. **SCORING AREAS AND PROCEDURES:** Details on scorecard return procedures and scoring areas will be provided on the Notice to Players at each event.
25. **MODIFICATION OF PENALTY UNDER RULE 3.3b(2) FOR MISSING PLAYER OR MARKER CERTIFICATION:** Model Local Rule L-1 as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect.
26. **WHEN COMPETITION IS FINAL:** The competition is final when the trophy has been presented to the winner or, in the absence of a prize ceremony, when all scores have been approved by the Committee.
27. **UNSPORTSMANLIKE BEHAVIOR:** A player may be disqualified without warning for unsportsmanlike conduct such as throwing a club, disrespectfully addressing or striking another player or official, using profanity or obscene gestures, intentionally obstructing another player's line of play, etc.
 - A. Any disqualification for unsportsmanlike conduct disqualifies the player for the entire championship. Substitution of a player disqualified for unsportsmanlike conduct is not permitted.
 - B. Disqualification for a violation of USGA rules applies to that day's competition only.
