SUBJECT: Summary of Executive Board Action at the July 22-24, 2024, Summer Workshop

At the OSAA Executive Board Summer Workshop, the Executive Board took the following actions:

- Voted to adopt the 2024-25 Athletic Officials Handbook.
- Voted to amend Board Policies – Ejection Policies to require ejected players to complete the online NFHS Sportsmanship Course following an ejection, clearly define “out of sight” and “out of sound” for coach ejections, increase the fine for ejections in state championship playoff games, double the suspension period for ejections due to discriminatory language, entering the field during a fight, leaving the team box, and/or fighting, require that schools attend an OSAA Sportsmanship training class following three or more ejections in a program or five or more ejections overall in a school year, require schools reaching either threshold in consecutive years to appear in-person before the Executive Board, and indefinitely suspend any coach/player that has inappropriate physical contact with an official pending an in-person appearance before the Executive Board.
- Voted to amend Board Policy – State Championships – Rankings to update freeze dates, adjust deadlines for adding contests, clarify forfeits in football, outline league champion home game guarantee language for 6A football.
- Voted to approve the 2024-25 Eligibility Appeals Board Roster.
- Voted to approve Full Membership applications from Tualatin Valley Academy and Cascadia Preparatory Academy.
- Voted to approve an Independent Status petition for McKay – Softball.
- Voted to approve a Cooperative Sponsorship application for South Umpqua/Riddle – Girls Soccer.
- Voted to approve updates to the Cheerleading Scoresheets.
- Voted to delete Board Policy – Camps – Athletic Camps and Team Meals.
- Voted to amend Board Policy – Camps – Commercial Summer Camps.
- Voted to amend Board Policy – Independent Status in a Sport.
- Voted to amend Board Policy – Reporting Schedules, Rosters, and Results.
- Reviewed and assigned penalties for rule violations self-reported by member schools.
