SUBJECT: OSAA Football Ad Hoc Advisory Committee Update

The Football Ad Hoc Committee conducted a closed work session on April 25, 2021 via Zoom Conference to discuss placement recommendations for the Fall 2021 season.

OSAA staff shared responses to the recent AdHoc survey and all follow-up conversations with schools who did not respond. Below is a general summary:

- The survey received 207 responses (85%) and in general schools appear optimistic that participation numbers will increase next year even though some schools did report an expected decline.
- 64% of respondents did not support using Season 2 data
- Teams planning cooperative sponsorships were identified
- Teams planning to participate at the 8-player and 6-player levels were identified

The Committee reviewed and discussed their Fall 2020 recommendations that were adopted by the OSAA Executive Board but were not fully implemented due to the pandemic. During this review the group did reach consensus that data from Season 2 would not be used to evaluate school placement for the Fall 2021 season thus not requiring any recalculating of 2-year or 4-year data.

Given the above, the group currently supports moving forward using the same recommendations with the following modifications:

- Colton moved from 2A SD2 to SD1 for league balance
- Regis moved from 2A SD3 to SD2 for league balance
- Schools participating in the 1A 8-player will be organized into two Special Districts instead of three.
- Butte Falls, Elkton, Mapleton, Powers, Riddle, Siletz Valley move from 8-player to 6-player
- Chemawa moves to Independent 8-player
- Allocations at the 1A 8-player to be determined by the Executive Board

## Recommended Allocations/Bracket Structure (see attached League/Special District recommendations)

3A	16	SD1 – 6 teams, SD2 – 6 teams, and SD-3 – 2 teams, plus 2 via rankings
2A	16	3 teams per SD, plus 1 via rankings

The following timeline will be used to finalize all recommendations related to Fall 2021 placements. All recommendations will be forwarded to the OSAA Executive Board for consideration.

Tuesday, April 27 Schools provided current recommendations

Tuesday, May 4 Deadline to submit requests for committee consideration

Monday, May 10 Committee meeting to finalize and submit recommendations to OSAA Executive Board

Kevin Hatfield (OSAA Football SRI) outlined two potential NFHS Football rules experiments and received positive feedback from the group. Chris Knudsen indicated that moving forward with the experiments is also supported by an OACA survey of their membership. The final steps in the process are approval to conduct the experiments from both the OSAA Executive Board and NFHS Football Rules Committee.
