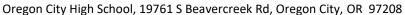

"one . . ." (cue for the last 8 count of step-touches, hitting pose on count 8: R dig, head/arms down)

Note:

- 1. Step-touches start straight up off your L knee on count 1 of your cue words with the R foot, touch L, then rock back to continue step-touches facing front until after the last team (Pendleton) has joined in arms swinging straight.
- 2. Everyone holds pose after step-touches for **8 cts**. before dancing starts (hips).
