The OSAA Staff wanted to get the following updates/clarifications out to member schools:

## **OUTDOOR SPORTS IN EXTREME COUNTIES**

Yesterday, the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) updated the <u>Sector Risk Level Guidance Chart</u> for <u>Extreme Risk Counties</u> in <u>Outdoor Sports and Activities</u> which increased the maximum gathering size to the following:

- <u>100</u> maximum (competitors, officials, staff all count) field capacity at the same time. For track, the infield is the area bounded by the outside lane of the track.
- 100 maximum spectators (if in an area with separate entrances, exits and restrooms from the participants).

## INDOOR FULL-CONTACT SPORTS IN EXTREME COUNTIES

In addition, we obtained clarification from OHA on Indoor Full-Contact Sports and Activities for Extreme Risk Counties:

- The school opt-in for indoor full-contact sports and activities does allow students to have contact with one another
- Even if a school opts-in for indoor full-contact sports, the OHA's capacity limits remain in effect (similar to Season 2 volleyball). Indoor facility capacity is limited to six (6) students with a limited number of coaches to supervise.

## MASKS REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPANTS FOR OUTDOOR EVENTS

We aware of continuing conversations regarding the mask requirements for participants for outdoor events and will send any updates as they are available.

We apologize for all of the e-mails but it is our goal to keep the membership informed of the updates and clarifications from the Oregon Health Authority and the Governor's Office on their guidance as it comes available.
