Yesterday Governor Brown lifted the statewide mandate requiring masks and venue capacity limits, effective immediately. As a result, the OHA has also removed its indoor and outdoor recreation guidance from their website. We are working to update the OSAA website accordingly.

As with the [Ready Schools, Safe Learners Resiliency Framework for the 2021-22 School Year](#) ODE sent out last Friday, the vast majority of health and safety protocols which have been mandatory, such as face coverings, are now advisory. This shifts to a more traditional, local decision-making model and means school districts, public charter schools and private schools will have the option to implement, as appropriate, relevant advisory guidance from the federal Centers for Disease Control and the Oregon Health Authority, and may require face coverings, physical distancing and other measures.
