

- 4. WARM-UPS: Please note that there will be community warm-up spaces available. Percussion, String Bass and Cello will be on the first floor. ALL other warm-ups will be on the third floor only. There will not be individual warm-up rooms available for participants nor will pianos be provided in any of the warm-up rooms. The only warm-up room available with a piano is for accompanist warm-up which students nor directors will have access to. Warming up outside the rooms and on campus grounds is prohibited. Warm-up rooms are subject to change.
- 5. LODGING AND VISITOR INFORMATION: Schools are to make their own arrangements for lodging.

- 1. <u>CHECK-IN</u>: No check in is necessary. Students just need to be at their assigned location at their assigned time on campus. A welcome table will be set up in the main entrance area if assistance is needed to navigate the campus.
- 2. <u>MUSIC ETIQUETTE GUIDELINES</u>: Please encourage parents, school staff and administrators to attend and support your student's performance. Spectators will be allowed entry into the performance area only when the doors are open between performances.
- 3. <u>SERVICE ANIMALS</u>: Trained guide dogs and service animals assisting guests are welcome at OSAA State Championships. All other animals are prohibited. All service animals must remain on a leash or in a harness, and be in full control of the handler, at all times. Handlers are responsible for any damage or injuries caused by their animals, must properly dispose of waste in appropriate containers and must take appropriate precautions to prevent property damage or injury.




3. MINI REPLICA TROPHIES: www.osaa.org/shop#trophies




