1) **3-DAY TICKETS:**

- a) Adult 3-Day Ticket: Rose Quarter Box Office / **\$66.75**; Internet / **\$66.60 + \$5 per order**
- b) Student 3-Day Ticket: Rose Quarter Box Office / **\$41.00**; Internet / **\$40.85 + \$5 per order**

2) **2-DAY TICKETS (either 4A, 3A, 2A, 1A Thursday/Friday OR 6A, 5A Friday/Saturday):**

- 1) Veterans Memorial Coliseum is now a fully mobile building. When you check out the only option is digital delivery. If for some reason you are not able to access your ticket digitally, they will troubleshoot that on the day of the event at the box office. - 2) Pre-purchase parking passes **WITH** your ticket order for **\$15 + \$.50** fee (per weekday and Saturday before 3pm), **\$30 + \$.50** (Saturday after 3pm), and are limited to availability.
- 3) If parking passes are purchased separately from your ticket order, cost is **\$15 + \$.50** fee (per weekday and Saturday before 3pm), **\$30 + \$.50** (Saturday after 3pm), and are limited to availability + **\$5 per order**.

C. **Additional Parking Information:** Parking lot will not be available for RV's, Motor Homes or other overnight camping. Day of Show parking is based on availability. **Parking rates are subject to change based on the Rose Quarter event schedule.**

4. PROHIBITED ITEMS:

A. Bags and full-length umbrellas are not allowed in the arena. Exclusions apply for medical bags, children's bags and clutches 5"x 8" or smaller. Bags larger than 14" x 14" x 6" and backpacks are not permitted. Bag check is available.

B. **Ticketed guests cannot bring food in the main entrance.**

6. PARKING:

A. **Spectator Parking:** Please inform your parents and fans that the **PARKING LOT WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE FOR RV's, MOTOR HOMES, OR OTHER OVERNIGHT CAMPING.**

1) **Pre-purchase parking passes WITH** your ticket order for **\$15 + \$.50 fee** (per weekday and Saturday before 3pm), **\$30 + \$.50** (Saturday after 3pm), and are limited to availability. **If parking passes are purchased separately from your ticket order, add \$5 per order.**

2) **Day of Event Parking:** Parking is available onsite based on availability. **Parking rates are subject to change based on the Rose Quarter event schedule.**

Recording video of state championships from seating area is allowed provided the view of spectators is not obstructed. Use of a tripod in seating area is prohibited due to safety reasons. An official school video recorder, identified prior to an OSAA state championship event by the head coach or athletic director of a participating school, will be allowed in a designated area established by the OSAA.

NOTE: Recording video is for private use only. Broadcasting or streaming video - live or delay - is prohibited unless an online registration form has been submitted and approved by the OSAA. Those approved for broadcasting / streaming OSAA state championship events declined by the NFHS Network shall pay a rights fee to the OSAA.

9. **SERVICE ANIMALS:** Trained guide dogs and service animals assisting guests are welcome at OSAA State Championships. All other animals are prohibited. All service animals must remain on a leash or in a harness, and be in full control of the handler, at all times. Handlers are responsible for any damage or injuries caused by their animals, must properly dispose of waste in appropriate containers and must take appropriate precautions to prevent property damage or injury.
10. **LOST AND FOUND:** During the event, Lost & Found will be at the OSAA Event Office or other location designated by the host facility / OSAA Staff. The Veterans Memorial Coliseum Guest Information Booth is located at Entry CC. The Guest Services staff will assist you with questions, wheelchair escorts, Assisted Listening Devices and Lost and Found inquiries during events. If you lose something during an event, stop by one of our information booths and fill out a Lost & Found form. Make sure to stop by after the event and double check if your item has been turned in. Lost and Found items may be picked up from the Facility Security department, Monday through Friday 9am to 4pm. 12. **PARADE OF CHAMPIONS:**

- A. We expect the top six finishers in each weight class at the **4A classification and the top four at the 3A, 2A/1A and 4A/3A/2A/1A Girls classifications** to take part in the Parade of Champions on Friday evening at 6:30pm. **Participants are asked to appear in uniform** and report to the weigh-in area (Exhibit Hall by 6:00pm on Friday, **February 24**).
- B. We expect the top six finishers in each weight class at the **6A, 5A classifications and the top four at the 6A/5A Girls classification** to take part in the Parade of Champions on Saturday evening at 6pm. **Participants are asked to appear in uniform** and report to the weigh-in area (Exhibit Hall by 5:30pm on Saturday, **February 25**).

13. **AWARDS:** Team trophies will be presented at the conclusion of the event on **Friday evening (4A, 3A, 2A/1A, 4A/3A/2A/1A Girls) and Saturday evening (6A, 5A, 6A/5A Girls)**. Individual medals will be presented to the top placers in each classification following the championship match in each weight class.

- A. **Trophies:** Champion through fourth place trophies will be presented to the top teams in each classification.
- B. **Medals:** Individual medals will be presented to the top six finishers in each weight class at the **6A, 5A, 4A classifications, and the top four finishers at the 3A, 2A/1A, 6A/5A Girls, and 4A/3A/2A/1A Girls**.
- C. **Moda Athlete of the Meet:** The top wrestler in each classification will be recognized as that classification's Moda Athlete of the Meet. The following criteria will be used to determine the top wrestler:
 - 1) Number of State Championships
 - 2) Points scored in the tournament
 - 3) Higher team score
 - 4) Year in school

The winners will be announced over the PA and will receive a commemorative coin from Moda Health and a scholarship application during the award ceremony. If not handed out, it will be mailed to the school athletic director the week following the championship.
