SUBJECT: Update on the Proceedings of the Classification and Districting Committee

The Classification and Districting Committee for the 2022-26 four-year time block held its third public meeting at the Holiday Inn Express, Wilsonville on October 11, 2021 to receive testimony and review written correspondence thus far received. The Committee will be utilizing a hybrid format for all meetings that allows both committee members and those seeking to provide input the option of participating in-person or via webinar. The public portion of all meetings will be streamed live to the OSAA YouTube channel.

After Committee introductions, the group received a review of the changes to the Computation of ADM since the last time block, a review of the Committee standing charge and additional charges from the OSAA Executive Board, a review of the timeline and an explanation of the meeting and testimony procedure. The reviews were conducted by OSAA Executive Director Peter Weber, Assistant Directors Brad Garrett and Kyle Stanfield and Committee Chair Misty Wharton.

There have been significant changes since the conclusion of the last Classification and Districting Committee in 2017. Beyond the changes to the Computation of ADM and timeline for the process (memo can be found HERE), the Executive Board also confirmed that the *OSAA Football Ad Hoc Advisory Committee is again charged with reviewing and providing recommendations related to football classifications, districts and structure during the new time block.* Football Ad Hoc intends to convene after the conclusion of the regular season to begin deliberations on recommendations to be forwarded to the Executive Board for review and consideration at their February 2022 meeting.

The Committee wants to remind the membership that all play up, play down, geographic exceptions, cooperative sponsorships and independent status petitions dissolve with every time block (i.e. the end of this year). October 1 was the deadline for petitions to be received. As of October 1, the OSAA received 5 Petitions to Play Down and 15 Petitions to Play Up. The Play Up Petitions are automatically granted and reflected in the proposal. One of the schools petitioning to play down (McKay-6A) met all four criteria within the policy (see criteria HERE) and was moved down by the Executive Board. The other four petitions did not meet all criteria and will be decided on by the Executive Board at a future meeting.

The Committee received testimony from three individuals online and 10 individuals in person. A multitude of people watched the meetings live stream via the OSAA's YouTube channel. The Committee then adjourned to a closed work session to review and discuss the testimony, written correspondence, and documents prepared by the OSAA staff prior to the meeting.

The Committee felt it was important to reinforce to the membership that this Classification and Districting proposal <u>does not</u> include the sport of football. As mentioned, the Football Ad Hoc Committee will begin their work later this year to discuss football separately. Some of the Football Ad Hoc work will start from the overall structure of the Classification and Districting Committee's recommendations but football will continue to be discussed separately.

The Committee understands that there are pro's and con's to each system and that a school's placement is a very important decision for many communities. Throughout the last time block conversations of more schools in a league, more schools in a classification, less travel and more competitiveness were all expressed. The Committee acknowledges that achieving desired outcomes for all 295 schools and their unique circumstances is not possible. The Committee is focused on addressing as many aspects of their charge as possible while knowing that each aspect of the charge is interrelated to the next.

Due to the condensed timeline the Committee felt it was important to narrow their focus to one classification structure coming out of their October 11 meeting. This allows conversations to be focused for the November meetings prior to being presented to the Executive Board in December.

The Committee has created <u>Draft #5 – 6 Classification and is seeking feedback on the cutoff points, league alignments and school placement. Please note that this is a draft proposal and is not a final recommendation.</u> Compared to Draft #3 – 6 Classification the following are highlighted changes:

- 6A: The cutoff to the 6A classification (1000) was not adjusted. McKay's Petition to Play Down was honored and they were moved to the 5A classification. Due to the opening of Caldera High School and the realignment of attendance boundaries in the Bend-La Pine School District, the Committee requested and the school district provided thorough projections of their enrollments down to the current fifth grade through 2026. With those forecasts, the enrollments for the four largest Bend-La Pine Schools fell under 1000 and they were moved to the 5A classification.
- 5A: The lower cutoff was moved from 515 up to 590 which moved a handful of schools to the 4A level. Two of the largest points of emphasis in the 5A classification is the Intermountain Conference and the reduced travel for schools associated with the conference. Additionally, the seven team Midwestern League is important to keep intact along with the seven team 6A Southwest Conference. Having these leagues both with a seven-team alignment allows them to crossover locally when scheduling.
- 4A: With the upper move to 590, perennial 4A schools returned to the classification. The bottom number of the 4A classification was moved from 271 to 310 which moved several schools to the 3A classification.
- 3A: Moving the upper end from 270 to 309 added six schools to the classification. The Committee realigned the upper three conference/leagues accordingly.
- 2A & 1A: Upper nor lower cutoffs were adjusted.

Based on the testimony and correspondence received, the Association seems somewhat divided on which structure works best for the students, schools and communities in our state. The Committee felt that while there was some support for a 5-Classification approach, they believe that the majority of the Association is not supportive of such a significant change, especially during a pandemic. In reviewing its charge, along with the testimony and correspondence received, committee members reached consensus to support remaining with a 6-Classification structure which they believe best meets the needs and desires of the overall membership. The Committee looks forward to continuing to work through the process to review cutoff points, league alignments, and school placements to meet their charge and address concerns from the membership.

The next public meeting of the Classification and Districting Committee will be at 9am on Monday, November 1, 2021 at the Holiday Inn Express, Wilsonville. The general format for the meeting will be for the committee to receive public testimony followed by a closed work session.

The Committee will continue to meet throughout the Fall and will make its final recommendations to the OSAA Executive Board at the December 13, 2021 meeting.
