SUBJECT:	Update on the Proceedings of the Classification and Districting Committee and Final Recommendation

The Classification and Districting Committee for the 2022-26 four-year time block held its fifth and final public meeting at the Holiday Inn, Wilsonville on November 22, 2021 to receive testimony and review written correspondence received. The Committee has been utilizing a hybrid format for all meetings that allows both committee members and those seeking to provide input by participating in-person or via webinar. The public portion of all meetings is streamed live to the OSAA YouTube channel.

After Committee introductions, the group received a review of the changes to the <u>Computation of ADM</u> since the last time block, a review of the Committee standing charge and additional charges from the OSAA Executive Board, a review of the timeline and an explanation of the meeting and testimony procedure. The reviews were conducted by OSAA Executive Director Peter Weber, Committee Chair Misty Wharton and OSAA Assistant Executive Director Kyle Stanfield.

The Committee received testimony from two individuals online and eight individuals in person. A multitude of people watched the meetings live stream via the OSAA's YouTube channel. The Committee then adjourned to a closed work session to review and discuss the testimony and written correspondence received.

The Committee acknowledges that achieving desired outcomes for all 295 schools and their unique circumstances is not possible. The Committee recognizes that any decision regarding placement of a school has the potential to substantially impact a school and its community. The Committee is focused on addressing as many aspects of their charge as possible while knowing that each aspect of the charge is interrelated to the others. There is simply no scenario that exists to positively impact every school.

During the work session, the Committee spent considerable time putting together their final recommendation to the OSAA Executive Board. They discussed both the written and verbal testimony received that day and at previous meetings. This Final Recommendation will be presented to the OSAA Executive Board and Delegate Assembly on Monday, December 13<sup>th</sup>. The Board will consider member school written input and public testimony prior to acting on the Committee's Final Recommendations, and the Delegate Assembly will meet to act on cutoff points and league quantities for the new time block.

The Committee felt it was important to reinforce to the membership that this Classification and Districting proposal <u>does not</u> include the sport of football. The Football Ad Hoc Committee has begun their initial work but with this committee's recommendations and the end of the football season, the group will ramp up its work.

Following the closed work session, the Committee reached consensus on the following issues:

Number of Classifications: The Committee is supporting a six-classification model.

**Petitions to Play Up:** The Committee recognizes the desires from some schools to play at a higher classification than their enrollment number may place them. Play up requests were received from Benson (6A), Jefferson PDX (6A), McDaniel (6A), Roosevelt (6A), Jesuit (6A), Central Catholic (6A), Gresham (6A), Nelson (6A), Sandy (6A), Lake Oswego (6A), Lakeridge (6A), La Salle Prep (5A), Parkrose (5A), Banks (4A), Horizon Christian (Tualatin) (3A), Westside Christian (3A), Columbia Christian (2A) and Western Christian (2A).

<u>Petitions to Play Down</u>: The Committee recognizes and supports the petitions to play down approved by the OSAA Executive Board for school who met the established criteria. Approved petitions to play down include McKay (6A to 5A), Centennial (6A to 5A), Gervais (3A to 2A) and Illinois Valley (3A to 2A).

**School Enrollment Projections:** Committee members heard from schools about their desire to change their proposed placement based on current enrollment for this year and into the future. Historically the OSAA's Classification and Districting Committee hasn't placed schools based on projections, so it can use consistent data for all schools. An exception to that occurs when a school district opens a new full member school leading to an adjustment of enrollment boundaries for its other full member schools. Once a new four-year time block begins, the Executive Board will review school enrollment figures each December and has the authority to make emergency changes on a case-by-case basis per Article 6.2.2.

## **Classification Breakdown:**

<u>**1A:**</u> (Cutoff Ratio – NA). The Committee received minimal written and/or verbal testimony from 1A schools. The Committee continues to support the cutoff between the 1A and 2A classifications at 74. Input received regarding the impact of the new cutoff points on cooperative sponsorships will be addressed through a specific recommendation to the Executive Board.

**<u>2A</u>**: (Cutoff Ratio – 1.93). The Committee spent significant time discussing this classification and its structure. The Committee believes that the upper and lower ends of the classification are appropriate considering the schools around the cutoff numbers. The Committee is recommending four leagues, including two leagues of 12 teams. This structure allows schools greater flexibility with scheduling and travel.

<u>**3A**</u>: (Cutoff Ratio – 2.12). The Committee received significant feedback from the classification and schools at the lower end of the classification. The group understands those requests but believes that the overall impact of changing the lower end cutoff would result in significant geographical issues for many affected schools. Like the 2A, the Committee felt that a larger league in southern Oregon allows schools flexibility in scheduling but also guarantees games for outlying schools.

**<u>4A</u>**: (Cutoff Ratio – 1.95). The Committee moved the upper cutoff point to 607 which brought Crook County and St. Helens into the classification. This move stabilizes the classification at 32 teams overall. The structure remains fairly similar to previous time blocks.

**<u>5A</u>**: (Cutoff Ratio – 1.65). The Committee slightly modified both the upper and lower classification cutoffs to the 5A. For most of the classification the structure remains similar to the current alignment.

<u>6A</u>: (Cutoff Ratio – NA). The Committee modified the lower end of the classification to provide flexibility for future school enrollment fluctuations. The Committee heard testimony to modify league structures but ultimately felt the current proposal best fit the overall charge and they did not want to change historic league alignments.

<u>Additional Committee Recommendations</u>: The Classification and Districting Committee has two additional recommendations for the Executive Board after having been through this process:

- 1. Creation of a task force to review current Cooperative Sponsorship policies for potential changes. Committee members recommend that this review occur soon for potential changes to be effective beginning next school year.
- 2. Reconvene the Petition to Play Down Task Force to continue their review of the current criteria and explore the feasibility of additional criteria for schools that have previously played down and are seeking to stay at a lower classification for a subsequent time block.

The release of the Committee's Final Recommendation is not the final step in the public process. Member schools and the public will also have the opportunity to respond to the Committee's Final Recommendation to the Executive Board in writing prior to and/or in person at the public meeting at which the Board will act on the Final Recommendation on December 13, 2021, at the Holiday Inn, Wilsonville. The Board will meet at 9am to consider member school written input and public testimony prior to acting on the Committee's Final Recommendation, and the Delegate Assembly will subsequently meet at 1pm to act on cutoff points and league quantities for the new time block.
