SUBJECT: Summary of Delegate Assembly Action at the December 13, 2021, Meeting

At the meeting on December 13, 2021, the OSAA Delegate Assembly took the following actions:

- Voted to Amend Article 6.2.4. – Classification Thresholds which amends current classification cutoff points as adopted by the Executive Board. **(Attached)**
- Voted to Amend Article 7 – Representative Districts which amends the regular districts at each classification level as adopted by the Executive Board. **(Attached)**
- Voted to Amend Article 4.1. – Delegate Assembly which amends Delegate Assembly composition due to changes in the number of Representative Districts. **(Attached)**

### Article 6.2.4. – Classification of Schools – Classification Thresholds

**Classification of Schools – Classification Thresholds.** During the four-year time block, the following Average Daily Membership (ADM) thresholds will be used by the Executive Board when considering school placement or classification changes:

6A: <del>1260 or more</del>	<b>1005 or more</b>
5A: <del>665 to 1259</del>	<b>608 to 1004</b>
4A: <del>350 to 664</del>	<b>311 to 607</b>
3A: <del>206 to 349</del>	<b>146 to 310</b>
2A: <del>90 to 205</del>	<b>75 to 145</b>
1A: <del>10 to 89</del>	<b>10 to 74</b>

### Article 7 – Representative Districts

**7.1 Regular and Special Athletic Districts.** The high schools of the state shall be divided into seven regular athletic districts for 6A, four regular athletic districts for 5A, six regular athletic districts for 4A, six regular athletic districts for 3A, ~~six~~ **four** regular athletic districts for 2A and eight regular athletic districts for 1A as follows:

**7.1.1 6A:** Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7

**5A:** Districts 1, 2, 3, 4

**4A:** Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6

**3A:** Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6

**2A:** Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, ~~5, 6~~

**1A:** Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8

## Proposal to Amend Article 4.1. – Delegate Assembly – Composition

(Action Item)

**QUESTION:** *Should the Delegate Assembly amend Article 4.1 – Delegate Assembly – Composition to reflect changes in the composition of the Delegate Assembly as a result of changes in the number of Representative Districts?*

**RATIONALE:** The Classification and Districting Committee recommended changes to the total number of districts to the Executive Board for consideration. The Delegate Assembly must vote to amend the composition of the Delegate Assembly to reflect these changes as they are contained in the Articles of the OSAA Handbook.

### Article 4 – Delegate Assembly

**4.1. Composition.** The Delegate Assembly shall be composed of ~~42~~ **40** representatives:

- 4.1.1.** Thirty-~~seven~~ **five** representatives elected by the members of regular athletic districts.
- 4.1.2.** An athletic director representative elected by the Oregon Athletic Directors Association.
- 4.1.3.** An activities director representative selected by the OSAA Student Activities Advisory Committee.
- 4.1.4.** A school boards representative elected by the Oregon School Boards Association.
- 4.1.5.** A non-voting advisory coach representative elected by the Oregon Athletic Coaches Association.
- 4.1.6.** A non-voting advisory official representative selected by the Oregon Athletic Officials Association.
- 4.1.7.** The Executive Director shall be an ex-officio, non-voting member of the Delegate Assembly.
