a. Classification and Districting Committee

The OSAA Classification and Districting Committee has had two public meetings and another one will take place after the Delegate Assembly today. The Committee is looking for feedback from the membership on the current 6-Classification and 5-Classification proposals from their September 13 meeting.

What feedback does your school/league/classification have on the two proposals released on September 16? Does your school/league/classification favor one of the proposals? If so, why?

b. State Championship Committee

The OSAA State Championship Committee will begin their work later this Fall. The Committee will be looking for initial feedback from the membership on all aspects of current state championships, including what has worked well and what could be improved moving into the next time block.

What input does your classification have for the State Championship Committee to consider for the 2022-26 time block? This could include qualifying procedures, event formats/structures, championship venues/locations, reimbursement and any other items related to championship events.

c. Seniors – Less than Full Time Enrolled

During the pandemic, the OSAA has adjusted processes related to academic eligibility to continue to keep students engaged in interscholastic activities. This included leniency for participation when it came to seniors who were on track to graduate and enrolled in the necessary classes to graduate but were enrolled less than full time per OSAA rules.

Would your classification support a rule change that would amend the full-time enrollment requirements for seniors who are on track to graduate by allowing them to participate even if they are not enrolled full time per OSAA rules?

d. School Representation

There's been an increase in the number of schools unable to field programs in some activities due to participation numbers during the pandemic. This has led to more requests for opportunities for students to represent schools other than the one they attend, even at some of our larger 5A and 6A schools. However, current OSAA rules limit school representation for full member school students and prohibit co-ops for 6A schools.

Would your classification support a rule change allowing co-ops involving 6A schools? Would your classification support a rule change allowing students attending a school that drops a program to represent another school? Would your classification support a rule change allowing students attending a full member public charter school that doesn't offer an activity the opportunity to represent their resident public school? Would your classification support a rule change allowing students attending a full member public school that doesn't offer an activity the opportunity to represent another school?

e. District Committee Structure

Currently each league has a District Committee that reviews hardship transfer requests within their league. With 37 districts around the state, there has been inconsistency with eligibility decisions even when situations are similar. OSAA legal counsel has concerns that the inconsistency can leave the Association exposed and at risk. The OSAA Executive Board wants your feedback on two different potential options to address this issue.

Would your classification support creating regional hardship committees that would include representatives of different classifications to rule on transfer hardship requests? Would your classification support having all transfer hardship requests submitted to the OSAA office for rulings? Are there other ideas that your classification has to address this concern?
