Point 2 Basis for team selection

The state shall be divided into eight districts:

District 1, will include the following counties: Clatsop, Columbia, Tillamook, Washington, and Yamhill.

District 2, will include the following counties: Clackamas, Multnomah, Marion, Polk, Lincoln. (Gates, Mill City, and Scio of Linn County)

District 3, will include the following counties: Benton, Lane, and Linn.

District 4, will include the following counties: Douglas, Coos, & Curry.

District 5, will include the following counties: Josephine, Jackson, Klamath, and Lake.

District 6, will include the following counties: Crook, Deschutes, Jefferson, Wheeler, Gilliam, Sherman, Wasco, Hood River, and Heppner. of Morrow.

District 7, will include the following counties: Grant, Harney, Umatilla, and Morrow.

District 8, will include the following counties: Baker, Union, Malheur, and Wallowa.

The quarter-final games will be played as follows:

District #1 vs. District #2  
District #3 vs. District #4  
District #5 vs. District #6  
District #7 vs. District #8

The semifinal games will be played as follows:

Winner of District #1 and #2 plays winner of #3 and #4  
Winner of District #5 and #6 plays winner of #7 and #8

The quarter finals shall be played on the home field of the even number team. The games may be played elsewhere by mutual agreement. Any team refusing to comply with these rules shall automatically forfeit the game.

The location of the semifinals and championship game shall be decided by the Board of Control.

Point 2 Basis for team selection

The state shall be divided into four districts:

District 1 will include the following counties: Columbia, Clatsop, Tillamook, Washington, Multnomah, Clackamas, Marion, Linn, Benton, Lincoln, Polk, and Yamhill.

District #2 will include the following counties: Hood River, Wasco, Sherman, Gilliam, Wheeler, Crook, Deschutes, and Jefferson.

District #3 will include the following counties: Morrow, Umatilla, Union, Wallowa, Baker, Grant, Malheur, and Harney.

District #4 will include the following counties: Lake, Klamath, Jackson, Josephine, Curry, Coos, Douglas, and Lane.

The semifinal game will be played as follows:

District #1 vs. District #4

District #3 vs. District #2

Each district shall have a committee of three "B" school administrators and this committee shall meet by October 1, to work out plans for the district champion selection peculiar to that district, not otherwise covered by these rules. (In the formulation of said plans, consideration shall be given all schools) It shall be the duty of the chairman of this committee to send a copy of the plan to the O.S.A.A. office for approval before notifying schools in the district. The district committee shall continue to represent its district in the semifinal game.

In the championship flight, tie games shall be decided as follows:  
The team registering the highest total net yardage shall be declared the winner--if net yardage should be equal the team registering the most first downs shall be considered the winner.

EXCEPTION: Should the championship game end in a tie, the participating teams shall be declared co-champions.

Any team refusing to comply with these rules shall automatically forfeit the game.

The location of the semifinals and championship game shall be decided by the Board of Control.
