OSAA Coverage Issues Protocol

*Priority one is to make every attempt to play the game at the host site at the requested date/time.

Step 1 – Notify the school that coverage for the contest is not available as soon as possible and that you will be seeking coverage options from the nearest Oregon association. It is your obligation to fill the assignment if possible.

Step 2 – Contact the next closest Oregon association(s) to determine if they can cover the contest.

Step 3 – If the next closest Oregon association(s) cannot cover the contest then contact any other local associations (WA, ID) to determine if they have coverage options. Commissioner is responsible to notify the school of the expenses involved if using a crew from a different local association.

Step 4 (Playoffs) – OSAA staff is responsible to determine date, time, and site of the contests.

Step 4 (Regular Season) – Notify the member school that coverage is unavailable. The school now has the option to reach out and arrange coverage on their own if possible. Schools must use OSAA certified officials in that sport when required.

Step 5 (Regular Season) – Reschedule the contest to an alternate date or site and repeat Steps 1-4 if applicable.
